

Rehearsal & Concert Guidelines and Procedures

In Studio Rehearsals (6/10, 6/11)

1. All dancers check-in at front desk and report to their assigned dressing room and begin warming up.
2. Further instructions will be given by Project C faculty and volunteers.
3. Dancers will be dismissed upon final run through of their last dance.
4. All studio rules apply (i.e. no food or drink other than water allowed in the studios, no shoes in the studios, etc.)

In Studio Dress Rehearsal (6/12)

1. Dancers must arrive in complete hair and makeup with all costumes and shoes.
2. All dancers check-in at front desk and report to their assigned dressing room.
3. Place all costumes and bags neatly in each student's designated area.
4. Dancers should immediately dress in his/her first costume and begin warming up in his/her designated area.
5. Further instruction will be given by Project C faculty and volunteers.
6. Dancers will be dismissed upon final run through of their last dance.

Theater Dress Rehearsal (6/13)

1. Dancers arrive in complete hair and makeup with all costumes and shoes at Scott Center for the Performing Art.
**Please enter through the building's front doors. Theater will be directly ahead, check in desk at the entry to the hallway on the right.
2. All dancers must check-in upon arrival and will be given further instructions of where to go.
*Non-Volunteer parents are not permitted in the backstage area, with the exception of Creative Movement and Youth Combo parents.
3. Dancers should immediately dress in his/her first costume and begin warming up in their designated area and wait for further instructions from Project C faculty and volunteers.
4. Show will be run in full length and full costume (See Rehearsal Schedule for more details).
5. Dancers are asked to stay in their last costumes of the show after the first run through for Curtain Call.
6. Curtain Call will be rehearsed prior to the first run, and then as a part of the run.
7. Dancers must sign out prior to leaving for liability reasons.

Concert (6/14, 6/15)

1. Dancers arrive in complete hair, makeup and first costume with cover-up with all costumes and shoes at Scott Center for the Performing Arts no later than 5:30pm on Friday and/or 12:30pm Saturday.
**Please enter through the building's front doors
2. All dancers check-in upon arrival, then report to designated areas.
*Non-Volunteer parents are not permitted in the backstage area, with the exception of Creative Movement and Youth Combo parents. All dancers should immediately begin warming up/preparing.
4. Dancers will not be permitted to leave backstage area during intermission. Creative Movement Dancers and Youth Combo dancers may be in the audience for the first half and move backstage during intermission to perform for the second half. Creative Movement and Youth Combo parents are permitted to remain backstage with their dancers.
*Creative Movement and Youth Combo dancers must be seated on parents' laps unless a ticket has been purchased for the dancer. If an unsold seat is available, they may sit in those.
5. Dancers will be dismissed after curtain call and must be signed out from backstage area for liability reasons.

Basic Rules

1. Dancers MUST arrive on time. We will not hold any rehearsals or the show for late comers.
2. DO NOT ARRIVE MORE THAN 15 MINUTES EARLY.
2. ALL REHEARSALS ARE MANDATORY FOR PERFORMANCE.
3. Please have all costumes and shoes labeled with dancer's name or initials.
4. All costumes should be organized in order of performance.
5. No jewelry (except small studs/retainers in piercings) and no nail polish.
6. Parents are asked to refrain from observing In-Studio rehearsals as space is limited.
7. During Theater Dress Rehearsal dancers will be able to watch dances which they are not in either from the wings or audience.
8. Videography and non-flash photography ONLY. Video and images may be captured during Concert performance for Social Media sharing. Please tag @projectstudios and use the hashtags #projectstudios and #RESTLESSANDFREE18 when posting.
9. Dancers MUST wear a cover up while eating, entering and/or exiting backstage so as not to mess up their costumes.
10. **ABSOLUTELY NO FOODS CONTAINING NUTS/PEANUTS PERMITTED.** We have students with severe nut allergies.
11. Please have your dancer use the restroom immediately before check-in.
12. Only parents and siblings will be allowed in the theater during Dress Rehearsal for viewing.
13. All dancers must be signed out prior to leaving the building. Dancers ages 13 and over may sign themselves in and out of backstage.
