
#### **PARTS LIST:**

1	Elevation Rear Bumper Assembly	4	14mm x 28mm OD x 2.5mm Flat Washers
1	Driver/left Frame Bracket	12	12-1.75mm x 40mm Hex Bolts
1	Passenger/right Frame Bracket	24	12mm x 32mm OD x 3mm Flat Washers
2	Support Brackets (w-o rec hitch only)	12	12-1.75mm Nylon Lock Nuts
2	Plastic Plugs (license plate mount)	4	Sensor Hole Plugs
4	14-1.5mm x 55mm Fine Thread Hex Bolts	8	4mm x 10mm Socket Head Screws

#### PROCEDURE:

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX, VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. BUMPER IS HEAVY, ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED TO AVOID POSSIBLE INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE.


(Fig 1) Unplug and remove license plate lights and any bumper sensors. Move all wire harnesses away from bumper

- 1. Remove the license plate from the bumper. Next, unplug the license plate lights, trailer plug and sensors, (if equipped). Release the wiring harness from the clips attached to the back of the bumper, (Figure 1). Move all wiring harnesses away from bumper.
- 2. Determine if vehicle is equipped with factory receiver hitch Models without receiver hitch:
  - **a.** Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hex bolts, (3 per side), attaching the bumper brackets to the sides of the frame and slide the bumper assembly off of the vehicle, (**Figure 2**).

## Models with factory receiver hitch:

- a. Remove the plastic cover from the top of the bumper, (Figure 3). NOTE: Cover is attached at top, back and bottom by several plastic clips. Use a small flat blade screwdriver to carefully pry up the center pin to release each clip.




(Fig 5) Models with receiver hitch only, remove bumper but leave receiver hitch attached

- **b.** Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hardware attaching the bumper to the top and bottom of the receiver hitch and remove the bumper, **(Figures 4 & 5)**. **NOTE**: Leave hitch attached to vehicle.
- **3.** Remove the sensors, (if equipped), from bumper. Release the clips securing the trailer plug and remove the plug. Remove license plate lights.
- **4.** Optional accessory light installation, (sold separately).
  - a. Attach light to mounting tab on back of bumper. Repeat to install remaining light.

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- **b.** Follow light manufacturer's instructions for adjustment and to properly wire the light to the vehicle electrical system after Bumper installation.
- **5.** Depending on tow package, it may be necessary or easier to install sensors at this time, (if equipped), before installing the Bumper.

## **Models without bumper sensors:**

- **a.** Select the included (4) Rubber Plugs.


(Fig 6) Remove plugs from holes in bumper. Insert sensor (if equipped) into socket on back of bumper.

- b. From behind bumper, push plugs into sensor mounting holes, (Figure 6).

#### Models with bumper mounted sensors:

- **a.** Push the sensor into the mounting socket in the back of the bumper until it is as close to flush with the outside of the bumper.
- **b.** Secure each sensor to the socket with (2) 4mm x 10mm Button Head Screws, **(Figure 6)**. **IMPORTANT**: Sensors fit snug in sockets. The 4mm Screws are used to apply slight pressure to lock the sensors in place. Tighten both screws evenly until they touch the sensor body only. Do not overtighten screws or damage to sensors will result
- 6. Models without factory receiver hitch, (models with hitch, skip to Step 7):
  - a. Select (1) Support Bracket, (Figure 8). Attach the Support Bracket to the bottom of the frame with the included (2) 14mm Fine Thread Hex Bolts. (2) 14mm Lock Washers and (2) 14mm Flat Washers. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
  - **b.** Repeat the previous Step to install the passenger/right Support Bracket.
- 7. Select the driver/left Frame Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the inside of the mounting plate on the back of the Bumper with the included (4) 12mm Hex bolts, (8) 12mm Flat Washers and (4) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 9). Leave hardware loose at this time. Repeat to attach the passenger/right Frame Bracket to the Bumper.
- **8.** With assistance, hold the Bumper assembly with Brackets up to the outside of the frame and/or hitch. Temporarily support the weight of the Bumper **WARNING**: To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the bumper is fully and safely supported.

### Models without factory receiver hitch

- a. Reuse (1) factory hex bolt to attach the top mounting hole in the driver/left Bracket to the side of the frame. (Figures 10 & 12). Use (2) 12mm Hex Bolts, (4) 12mm Flat Washers and (2) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts to attach the Frame Bracket to the Support Bracket. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- b. Repeat to attach the passenger/right Bracket to the vehicle.


### Models with factory receiver hitch

- a. Reuse the (3) factory hex bolts to attach the driver/left Bracket to the outside of the hitch and factory support bracket, (Figures 11 & 12).
- **b.** Repeat to attach the passenger/right Bracket to the vehicle.
- **9.** Level and adjust the bumper and fully tighten all hardware. Slowly open tailgate and check for clearance. Adjust as necessary.
- **10.** Attach the wiring harness to the sensors and trailer plug. Secure the wiring harness to the bumper and frame as necessary.
- 11. Use the included (2) push-in plugs to attach the license plate to the Bumper, (Figure 13). Insert the License Plate Light into the hole in the Bumper. Connect the harness to the License Plate Light.
- **12.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

**To protect your investment**, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Rear Bumper assembly.

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

remove hex bolts attaching bumper to bottom of receiver hitch (arrow).


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#### **Driver/left Side Installation Pictured**

IMPORTANT: Sensors fit snug in sockets. The 4mm Screws are used to apply slight pressure to lock the sensors in place. Tighten both screws evenly until they touch the sensor body only. Do not overtighten screws or damage to sensors will result




(Fig 7) Models without receiver hitch, attach Support Bracket (see Fig 8) to the threaded holes in the bottom of the frame

- (2) 14mm Flat Washers




(Fig 8) Attach Support Brackets to frame (required on models without receiver hitch only)

- (4) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts




(4 12mm Flat Washers (2) 12mm Nylon Lock Nuts

(2) 12mm x 40mm Hex Bolts




(Fig 11) Driver/left side with hitch illustrated
