

HAZARD CHECKLIST

- 5. Use caution when using power tools such as air ratchet, etc.
- 6. Take caution when installing wiring.
- 7. Perform regular inspections of hardware, bolts, brackets, etc.

PREPARATION


- Ensure personal safety by checking for hazards and identifying risks.
- Check for correct hardware.
- Check for tools needed.
- Use either foam or tape on fenders to prevent scratches to the truck when installing your bumper.
- Please allow approximately 3-4 hours for installation.
- Disconnect the battery.

BUMPER REMOVAL

- 1. Disconnect the wiring harness from the 7 pin trailer plug on the inside of the bumper.
- 2. Disconnect the backup sensor and the license plate wiring harness.





- 3. Using a 15mm socket, remove the (2) bolts in the center of the bumper.
- 4. Using a 21mm socket, remove the (6) nuts and flag bolts from the frame on the driver and passenger side of the bumper. (Retain these bolts and nuts for installation of Bodyguard bumper mounts)






17-22 ONLY! DO NOT REMOVE FOR 23.

- 5. Remove the bumper from the vehicle.
- 6. Remove the (12) bolts in the bumper support brackets on the driver and passenger side using a 45 Torx bit.
- 7. Unclip the 7 pin trailer plug from the bumper and remove. (Retain plug for later use)






- 8. Then remove the support brackets in place to gain access to parking sensors and wiring harness.
- 9. Disconnect the parking sensors and license plate light plugs.



- 10. Remove the wiring harness from the bumper. (Retain harness for later use)
- 11. Use care and a pry tool, remove the parking sensors and bezels, and license plate lights from the bumper.





12. Use the ignition key to remove the spare tire lock from the bumper.






BUMPER INSTALL

1. Prior to attaching bumper: Install the top, center, and corner step plates in their correct position (inner/outer/driver/passenger) using the 1/4-20 x 5/8 Long, Stainless Steel (35x) (NOTE: STEP PLATES MAY HAVE BEEN PRE-INSTALLED AT POINT OF MANUFACTURE)




- 2. Install the 7-pin trailer plug and the license plate lights into the bumper.
- 3. Install and route the parking sensor harness through the bumper.
- 4. Install the plastic sensor bezels removed from the factory rear bumper into the sensor plates.
- 5. Once bumper is in place, secure the sensors and sensor plates in their correct orientation (inner/outer/driver/passenger).





Sensor plates need to be positioned so that the machined face is to the inside of the bumper like shown below. If installed incorrectly the backup sensors may not function correctly.





6. Install the spare tire lock into the bumper.


MOUNT INSTALL

1. Use the factory flag bolts and nut hardware to install the Bodyguard bumper mounts onto the frame loosely.



BUMPER INSTALL CONTINUED


1. Attach the bumper to the mounts with the 1/2"-13 x 1-1/2" Stainless Steel Hex Bolt hardware, leaving enough space to adjust the bumper as needed into position. Using a tape measure, adjust the bumper vertically and horizontally to the desired body gaps. Once the bumper is lined up, tighten all hardware for the bumper and the mounts. Using jack stands or an additional person to help support the bumper is recommended.

END CAP PLATE INSTALL

Install the end cap plates in their correct position (driver/passenger) using the 1/4-20 x 5/8 Long, Stainless Steel (4x) and either 1/4-20 Hex Flange Nut x4 (17-22) or 1/4 Clip Nut(2023).



PARKING SENSOR PLATE INSTALL

NOTE: If you are installing LED backup lights, do that before installing the inner sensor plates

- 1. Placing the sensor plates in their correct orientation (inner/outer/driver/passenger) install the sensor plates onto the bumper using the 1/4-20 x 5/8 Long, Stainless Steel (18x)
- 2. Connect the wiring harness to the parking sensors and the license plate lights on each side of the bumper and the trailer light plug.

LICENSE PLATE INSTALL

1. Insert Plastic License Plate Nuts into bumper and mount license plate using the License Plate Screw and a power drill.



NOTE: Wire in reverse lights as desired and check operation.

FINISHING UP

- Install shackles.
- Confirm that all hardware is tightened and everything is secure.
- Secure wiring harnesses for lights and sensors.
- Test all lighting and wiring before using vehicle (fog lights, sensors, etc.).
- Reconnect the battery.

MAINTENANCE

- Periodically check that all hardware is tightened and that all wiring and connections are secure.
- Periodically check that all sensor plugs are secure.
- Routinely wash bumper to maintain the powder coat finish.
