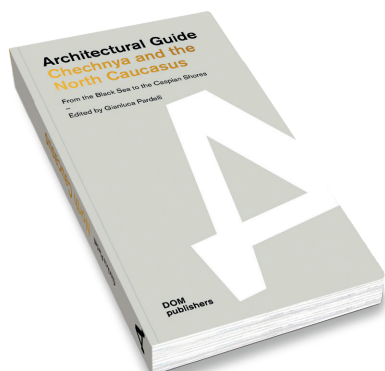


Chechnya and the North Caucasus Architectural Guide

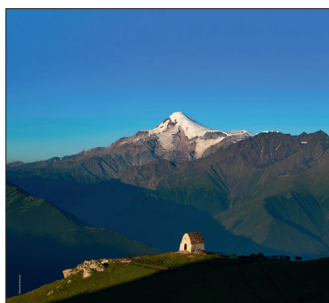
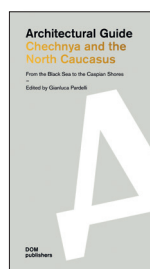
