

Common European Framework (CEFR)

TEEN is a language magazine which supports the study of English as a foreign language, following guidelines laid down in the Common European Framework (CEFR). The CEFR divides language learning into three levels (Basic User [A1, A2], Independent User [B1, B2], Proficient User [C1, C2]). TEEN magazine (upper-intermediate level) will take students from B2 to C1.

There are five issues of TEEN, divided into single topics designed to stimulate discussion at this upper-intermediate level of English. Each section can be adapted to suit your own lesson needs, either as stand-alone units or in conjunction with the students' text books. Graded language and vocabulary make TEEN a useful 'mini English course', written specifically for intermediate—advanced students.

In addition, new vocabulary and grammar are presented throughout the magazine, and the same learning objective is presented within the magazine in a variety of ways. This reinforces learning by:

- providing a strong, thematic approach, using topical and lively subjects designed to be of interest to young adult learners;
- helping students remember and learn new vocabulary and grammar, by presenting it to them several times;
- getting students to use what they have learned straight away – making passive knowledge active.


