This week we'll be making the last of our five square designs and we'll be making five color versions of the square. The skill level for this square is Intermediate. Below you'll find a list of the colors and quantities of yarn we'll be using this week.

### Tools

G size (4mm) crochet hook.  
Or a size suitable. Each square should measure approx. 26 cm x 26 cm. Gauge is not essential for this project.

Tapestry needle - for sewing in ends.

Optional: Blocking board and rust-proof pins.

slst	Slip Stitch
ch	Chain
chsp	Chain space
sc	Single Crochet
hdc	Half Double Crochet

Extsc	Extended Single Crochet
yrh	yarn round hook

### Special Stitches

#### Extsc = Extended Single Crochet

Insert hook into next stitch, yrh and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), yrh and pull through 1 loop on hook (2 loops on hook), yrh and pull through 2 loops on hook.

#### Picot:














































ch 3, slst in 1st ch made.

#### FPdc2tog = Front Post Double Crochet 2 Together

[yrh, insert hook from right to left behind post of next tr on round 3, yrh, draw through a loop, yrh, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice, yrh, draw through all 3 loops on hook.














































## Color Combinations - Graffiti

If you are using the Graffiti color pack, make one square in each of the following color combinations. When the patterns states to "join next color" use the next color in the combination:  
The joining color is Frost. Use this color for the last round on all squares.

## Color Combinations - Winter Is Coming

If you are using the Winter Is Coming color pack, make one square in each of the following color combinations. When the patterns states "join next color" use the next color in the combination.  
The joining color is Mist. Use this color on the last round of all squares.

## Square Instructions:

### Foundation Ring:

With first color, ch 4 and join to form a ring.

### Round 1:

ch 4 (counts as 1 dc, ch 1), [(1 dc, ch 1) into ring] 7 times in total, join with slst to 3rd of beginning ch 4. (8sts, 8 ch1sp)

### Round 2:

ch 1, [1 sc in dc, 1 sc in ch1sp] 8 times in total, join with slst to first st made. End color. (16sts)

### Round 3:

Join next color, ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), [1 tr in 1 st, ch 3, 1 tr in next st] 8 times in total omitting last 1 tr, join with slst to 4th of beginning ch 4. End color. (16sts, 8 ch3sp)

### Round 4:

Join next color, ch 1, [1 sc in 2 sts, (1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 tr) in ch3sp, 2 tr in 2 sts, (1 tr, 1 dc, 1 hdc) in ch3sp] 4 times in total, join with slst to first st made. End color. (48 sts)

### Round 5:

Join next color in next dc (5th st to left of join), ch 1, [1 sc in 2 sts, (1 hdc, 1 dc) in 1 st, Picot, 3 dc in 1 st, Picot, 3 dc in 1 st, Picot, (1 dc, 1 hdc) in 1 st, 1 sc in 2 sts, ch 2, skip 2 sts, FPdc2tog around posts of tr on round 2, ch 2, skip 2 sts] 4 times in total, join with slst to first st made. End color. (60 sts, 12 Picot)

### Round 6:

Join next color in top of FPdc2tog, ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 8 dc in same place, [ch 3, 1 sc in gap between 2 tr on round 4, ch 3, 9 dc in next FPdc2tog] 3 times, ch 3, 1 sc in gap between next 2 tr on round 4, ch 3, join with slst to 3rd of beginning ch 3. (40 sts, 8 ch3sp)

### Round 7:

ch 4 (counts as 1 dc, ch 1), [(1 dc, ch 1) in next st] 8 times, [ch 1, 1 sc in next sc, ch 2, [(1 dc, ch 1) in next st] 9 times] 3 times in total, ch 1, 1 sc in next sc, ch 2, join with slst to 3rd of beginning ch 4. End color. (40 sts, 8 ch2sp, 32 ch1sp)

### Round 8:

Join next color in last sc of previous round, ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 3 dc in same place, [ch 4, 1 dc in

2nd and 3rd unworked sts on round 4, ch 4, (3 dc, 1 tr, 3 dc) in next sc on round 7] 4 times in total omitting last ( ) group, 3 dc in same place as beginning sts, join with slst to 4th of beginning ch 4. (36 sts, 8 ch4sp)

### Round 9:

ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 1 dc in same place, [1 dc in each st and ch to next tr, (1 dc, 1 tr, 1 dc) in tr] 4 times in total omitting last ( ) group, 1 dc in same place as beginning st, join with slst to 4th of beginning ch 4. (76 sts)

### Round 10:

ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 2 dc in same place, [1 dc in each st to next corner tr, (2 dc, 1 tr, 2 dc) in tr] 4 times in total omitting last ( ) group, 2 dc in same place as beginning st, join with slst to 4th of beginning ch 4. (92 sts)

### Round 11:

Repeat round 9. End color. (100 sts)

### Round 12:

Join next color, ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 1 Extsc in same place, [1 Extsc in each st to next corner st, (1 Extsc, 1 dc, 1 Extsc) in corner st] 4 times in total omitting final ( ) group, 1 Extsc in same place as beginning sts, join with slst to 3rd of beginning ch 3. End color. (108 sts)

### Round 15:

Join next color and repeat round 12. End color. (116 sts)

### Round 16:

Join next color, ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 2 dc in same place, [1 dc in each st to next corner dc, (2 dc, 1 tr, 2 dc) in corner dc] 4 times in total omitting final ( ) group, 2 dc in same place as beginning sts, join with slst to 4th of beginning ch 4. End color. (132 sts)

### Round 17:

Using joining color, join in any corner tr, ch 1, [(3 sc in tr, 1 sc in each st to next corner tr] 4 times in total, join with slst to first st made. End joining color. (140 sts)

Sew in all ends.

# Front Post Double Crochet 2 Together . . .

1



Wrap yarn round hook. Insert hook to the right of next tr on round 3. Insert hook around the back of the stitch as pictured.

2



Wrap yarn round hook and draw through a loop. (3 loops on hook).

3



Wrap yarn round hook once and draw through 2 loops on hook. (2 loops remain on hook)

4



Repeat step 1 working around the next dtr on round 3. (3 loops on hook)

5



Wrap yarn round hook and draw through a loop. (4 loops on hook)

6



Wrap yarn round hook and draw through 2 loops on hook. (3 loop on hook)

7



Wrap yarn round hook and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

1sc in gap between 2 tr on round 4 . . .

1



Insert hook from back to front between 2 groups of 3 dc on round 5. Move hook down and insert from front to back between the 2 sts below.

2



Now work a single crochet stitch as normal.

## Blocking

Whether you choose to block or not is completely up to you. With acrylic yarn it isn't essential and when all the squares are joined they pull into shape anyway. If you do want to block I recommend lightly dampening the squares by spraying with lukewarm water. Then pin the squares out to 26 cm x 26 cm and leave to dry. You can pin out your squares on a blocking board, foam tiles or use an old towel.
