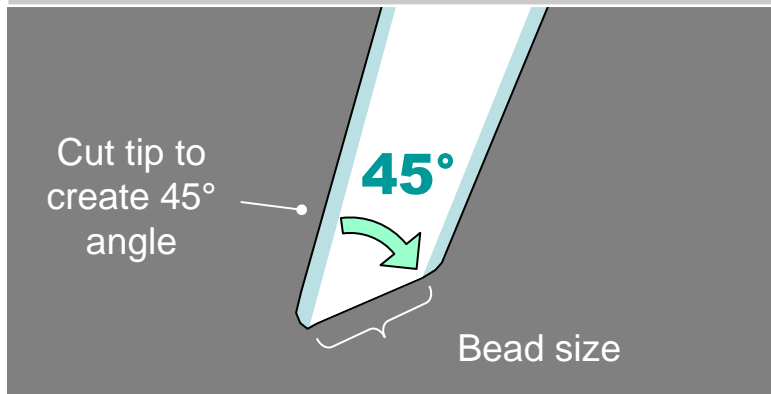


How to caulk indoors

APPLICATION STEPS

1. Clean area with warm water—do not use soap. Remove existing caulk, loose paint, dirt, mold, mildew, and anything that may reduce adhesion.
2. Cut the caulk tube at a 45° angle to create an applicator tip. Cut tip to create a 1/8" to 3/8" bead. Remember, caulk shrinks as it dries.
3. Surface must be dry and air and surface temperatures must be at least 65°F for 24 hours after application.
4. Apply using a caulk gun with a continuous, even pressure. Hold the caulk gun at a 45° angle, pulling toward you, pushing the bead into the gap. Start at a corner and apply in one continuous, consistent bead to the next corner.

FINISHING STEPS

1. Smooth, or “tool,” the bead to a concave shape using a caulk finishing tool or wet fingertip. Be careful only to shape the bead—not remove it!
2. Allow to dry before priming or painting; check label for proper cure.
