

Instruction Manual: Water Filter Assembly

Step 1 Your WaterMonster tank should have come with a Female to Female swivel fitting. Install it first, then install the short hose as shown.






Step 2 Screw your water source hose into the waterfilter inlet. Pay attention to the flow directional arrows.

Before hooking the filter into the WaterMonster tank, turn on your water source and allow water to flow freely through the water filter for a few seconds to flush out the filter.



Step 3 Turn the water source off, then screw the short hose into the top of the filter.





Technical Specs- Your WaterMonster filter is a carbon filter designed to remove chemicals for improved taste, and partical contaminants down to the 2 micron level. It is **NOT** designed to kill bacteria. If you feel your waters source is contaminated, have a water specialist test your water and advise for proper filtration.

Maintenance- Depending on how clean your water is, the filter should last for several thousand gallons before being replaced. Regardless of how many times you use your filter, it should be replaced every 6 months. Store in a dry area when not in use.
