### QUICKSTART GUIDE

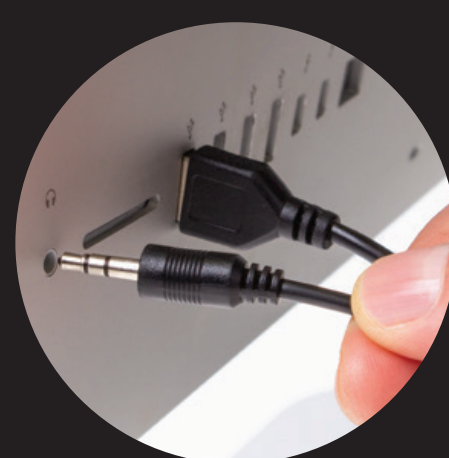
#### CAMERA SET UP

**1** Place camera facing the desired direction, ensuring a sturdy place is available to place mounting bracket.



**2** Once the camera is in place, gently press the adjustable arm down against the mounting surface to secure the camera in place.

**3** Insert the USB end of the camera's cable into the computer or device's USB port. Then connect the AUX end to the audio port of your device to enable sound. No software is necessary your computer or device will recognize the camera.



**4** Once mounting and installation is complete, and the camera is transmitting an image, adjust the focus if needed by twisting the lens manually to the left or right.

**5** The camera can be mounted on a tripod using the tripod socket on the adjustable arm. Alternatively, if no available object is present for mounting, you can rest the camera on the arm and use it as a stand.

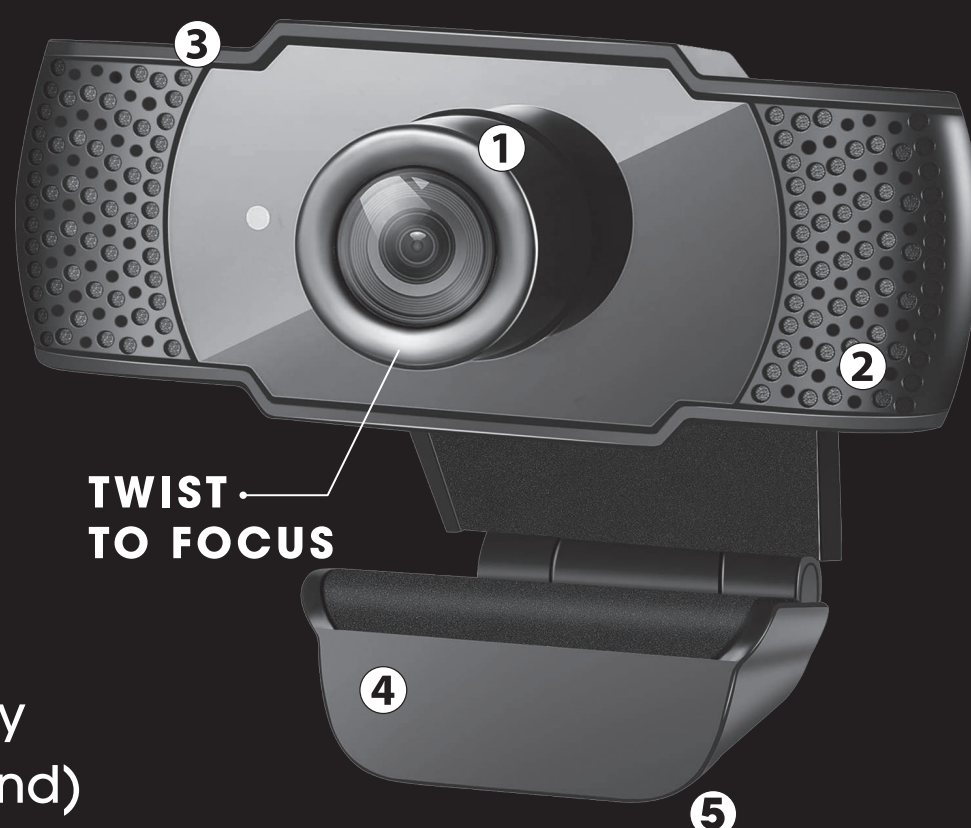
