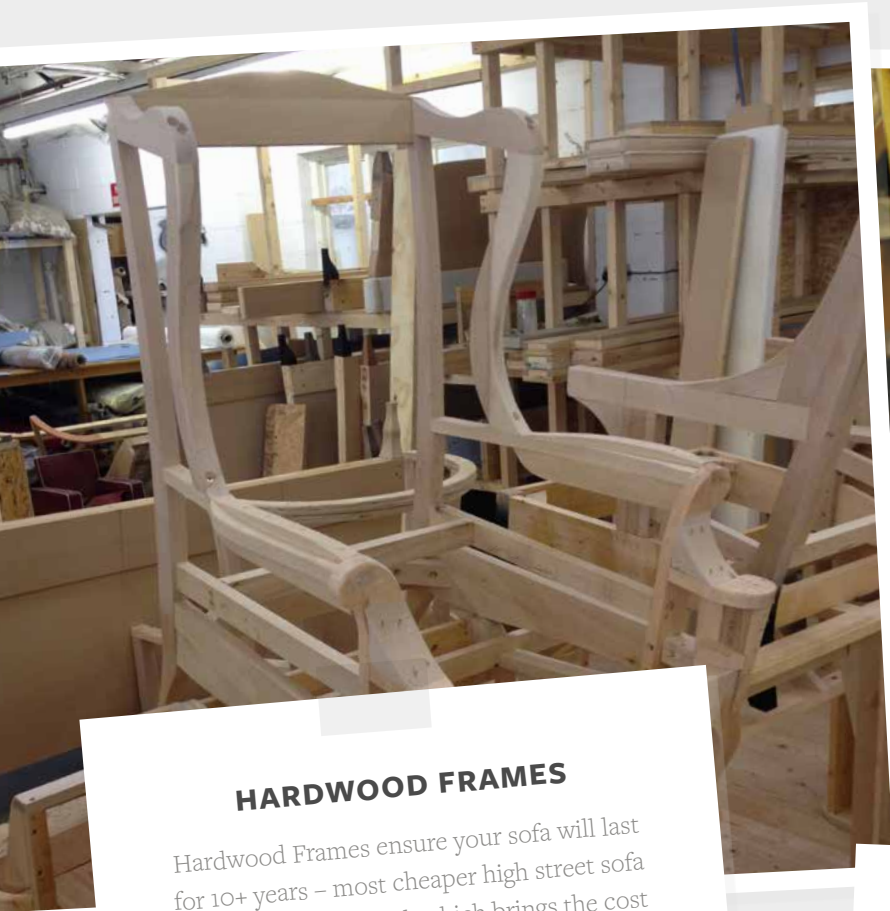

Hardwood Frames ensure your sofa will last for 10+ years – most cheaper high street sofa retailers use softwood, which brings the cost down but means your sofa may not last past 3+ years. Always try to buy the best you can for your budget – it will be cheaper in the long run, saving you time, effort and money and it's good for the environment too.



## SERPENTINE SPRINGS

A serpentine spring is known in the industry as the “No Sag Spring” due to its ability to bounce back and keep seats looking full without the need to plump.

## FEATHER & FIBRE CUSHIONS

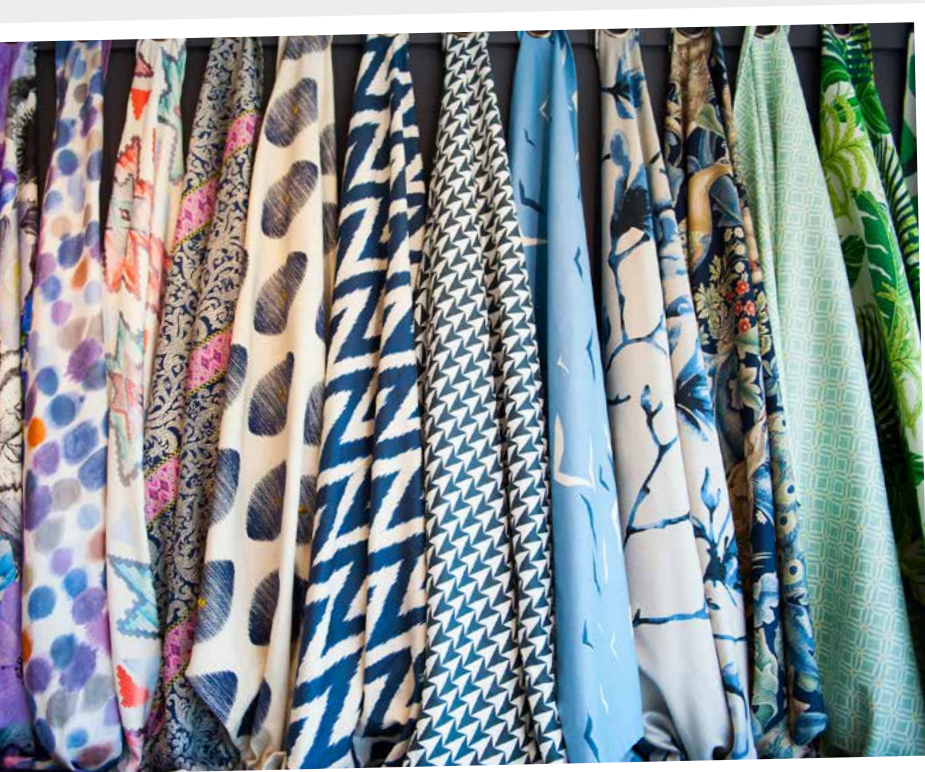

## Positioning tips

Try to resist pushing sofas up against the wall, bringing the sofa away from the wall will give a sense of space and moving a sofa into the middle of the room can create a natural divide and actually frees up wall space for a console with table lamp, art, or a book shelf.

Group the sofa with smaller items such as handy side table with a plant or reading lamp and a basket or two to hide away the general clutter that life accumulates. A rug in front or under a sofa works especially well to anchor the space.

Consider not only the depth of the sofa, but also the diagonal depth and diagonal height. Ideally you'll need to make sure any doors you need to access are 10cm wider than the depth or height.

## FREE DELIVERY

Free two man delivery with a pre agreed time slot. Our sofa's come with removable arms and often in two pieces which are then assembled in your home by our friendly delivery men. # How to style your sofa like a pro

Maxine Brady, top interiors stylist, magazine columnist and founder of the acclaimed WeLoveHomeBlog, shares her top sofa-styling tips.



## ZONE YOUR HOME

Firstly, don't feel sofas are just for living rooms. They come in all shapes and sizes and can slot into any space. It's my dream to have a bedroom which is big enough to fit a small sofa but if you have the space a sofa can look great in a hallway or in kitchen.

If you have an open-plan living space, try bringing your sofa into the middle of the room to create a natural divide, and free up wall space for furniture and art. Play around with your layout to make the most of the space.

My tip is to go for an L-shaped sofa; they are ideal for zoning your home.

## ALL IN THE DETAIL

Sofas are a large blank canvas where a few small changes and a couple of tweaks will make a big difference to the overall look of a room.

Consider all the little details – from covered buttons, leg shapes, straight or curved arms and plump-padded or sprung seats. These little touches will give your sofa a distinct style and personality.

Personally, I like to swap over my scatter cushions every so often. It's an easy and affordable way to revamp a sofa in an instant. Don't be scared to mix prints, adding trendy checks with polka dots and big floral motifs works really well.

As an interior stylist, using rugs underneath my sofa and throws over the top gives everything a homely layered look. I have a few throws that I drape over my sofa during the colder months.

## FABRIC IDEAS

If you want to make a style statement in your living room this winter; choose Velvet. Harlequin, Clarke & Clarke and Designers Guild do some lovely non shiny heavy cotton velvets perfect for upholstery. Pick a vibrant shade like midnight blue, deep purple, teal, burnt orange or even olive green to give your home a fashionable update.

For a more relaxed look, a neutral sofa in grey, off-white or greige fabrics won't date, particularly if you like to change your decor regularly and want a sofa that you can easily switch up with cushions and throws.

In busy family homes, a dark-coloured sofa will take a good thrashing from sticky hands and muddy paw prints. My top tip: opt for upholstery fabric with a decent stain resistant coating for a look that will last. The Villa Nova Cambay collection is specifically designed for life's thrills and spills.
