

Track Control

- Skip forward by holding > for 1-2 seconds
- Skip backward by holding < for 1-2 seconds

Volume Control

- Raise volume by pressing ^
- Lower volume by pressing v

Multi-Function Button: Music / Calls / Pairing

 Press @ once to Play / Pause OR Answer / Hang up Hold down for 6 seconds to enter pairing mode

POWER UP



For best results, fully charge your Los Cabos before use. There should be some charge when you turn on the headphones for the first time, but its better to be safe than sorry if you're using them for a long plane ride to Cabo or Rome.

To charge, connect your Los Cabos to your computer via the included USB to micro-USB cable. On the Right Ear Piece, there is a light indicator next to the charge port. The indicator illuminates with a RED light to show that the device is charging.

If the battery is dead, you can use the AUX jack located on the Left Ear Piece to plug in and continue to use your Los Cabos.

NOTE: It takes about 1.5 hours for a full charge.






To pair the headset with a Bluetooth-enabled device:

Prior to using Los Cabos for the first time, you will have to pair them with a Bluetooth-enabled device. The pairing procedure may be different for different models of devices. Please refer to your device's user manual for further information. The general pairing procedure is as follows:

- 1.) Place the Los Cabos and Bluetooth-enabled device no more than 3 feet apart.
- Hold the multi-function button down for 6-7 seconds or until the LED flashes red and blue alternately.
- Activate your device's Bluetooth function and set your device to search for Bluetooth devices within range. Select "ODT Los Cabos" from the list of devices shown.
- 4.) According to the indication, enter password or PIN No. "0000".
- 5.) If prompted by your device to connect, select "Yes" (this will vary among devices).
- 6.) After successfully connecting, the blue LED will flash two or three times every 4 seconds.

You should now be able to play music & make/receive calls using the headset. Hooray.

Microphone Use your Los Cabos to its fullest potential. Take phone calls, give lip to Siri, all while listening to your favorite tunes.



Great sound, great fit, and sweat resistant? We know, it's almost too good to be true. You can use these babies while watching Netflix in your bed or running on the treadmill in the gym! Be sure to close and secure the cover to the micro-USB port on the bottom of the Right Ear Piece and you're good to go!

TALK



The built-in microphone means that Los Cabos can be used as a wireless headset.

*NOTE: The built-in microphone only works when connected via Bluetooth.

The following are tips on how to use your Los Cabos to speak on the telephone:

Answer a call.........Press the multifunction button.

End a call	Press the multifunction button.
Decline a call	Press and hold the multifuntion
	button twice.
Make a call	Use your phone to dial as usual.
	Listen and talk through the Los
	Cabos.
Redial last number	Press the multifunction button
	twice.
Muto	Hold the multifunction button for

FAQ



What if I experience hearing distortion?

- A. Lower the volume on your Los Cabos and/or phone/device
- B. Make sure your Los Cabos are charged up.
 Check for low battery, then charge as necessary.

Why aren't my headphones louder?

- A. Turn up the volume on your device and/or your Los Cabos
- B. Make sure your Los Cabos are charged up.

Why can't I pair my headphones?

- A. Confirm that your device is Bluetooth compatible.
- B. Re-pair: follow pairing instructions in this guide

Why do I have Bluetooth signal loss/dropout?

- A. Move your Los Cabos closer to your device.
- B. Make sure your Los Cabos are charged up.
- C. Turn off your Los Cabos and device, then power up and reconnect.
