

# OT BLUETOOTH TAGS - HARDWARE



1	Loudspeaker
2	Charging jack
3	Multi-function button (MFB):
4	LED indicator
5	Built-in microphone
6	+ Button: Volume up
7	- Button: Volume down

OT Bluetooth Tags are a Bluetooth stereo headset. They support the following Bluetooth profiles:

HSP- Headset profile

HFP- Hands-free profile

A2DP- Advanced audio distribution profile

AVRCP- Audio/video remote control profile

# POWER/CONNECT

## Turning the Headset on/off

Function	Operation	LED Indicator
Power on	Press and hold MFB button for 3 - 5 seconds until blue LED flashes	Blue LED is on for 1 second.
Power off	Press and hold MFB button for 3 - 5 seconds until red LED flashes	Red LED is on for 1 second.

Note: In order to save power, the headset will turn off automatically if no devices have been connected for 5 minutes.

## Pairing the headset with Bluetooth devices

Function	Operation	LED indicator
Enter Pairing Mode	Ensure the headset is turned off. Press and hold MFB button for 6 - 7 seconds until LED flashes red and blue alternately.	LED flashes red and blue alternately.

Note: Pairing mode will last 2 minutes. If the headset hasn't paired with any Bluetooth devices after 2 minutes, it will return to standby mode automatically .

# FEATURES



Pairing with a Bluetooth cell phone or PDA-supported HFP profile allows the following:

- Answer a call, end a call or reject a call.
- Redial the last number
- Voice dial
- Adjust the volume
- Call transfer between the headset and your Bluetooth cell phone
- Microphone mute



Pairing with a Bluetooth music device or Bluetooth transmitter-supported A2DP profile allows the following:

- Enjoy music wirelessly
- Adjust the volume
- Remote control pause/play
- Remote control previous/next track

Notes:

- You may switch between a call and listening to music easily. You won't miss an incoming call while listening to music.
- Every time the headset is turned on, it will connect to the last connected device automatically.

## **PAIRING**



To pair the headset with a Bluetooth-enabled device:

Prior to using the OT Tags for the first time, you will have to pair them with a Bluetooth-enabled device. The pairing procedure may be different for different models of devices. Please refer to your device's user manual for further information. The general pairing procedures are as follows:

- 1.) Place the OT TAGS and Bluetooth-enabled device no more than 3 feet apart.
- 2.) Hold the MFB button down for 6-7 seconds or until the LED flashes red and blue alternately.
- 3.) Activate your device's Bluetooth function and set your device search for Bluetooth devices within range. Select "OT Bluetooth Tags" from the list of devices shown.
- 4.) According to the indication, enter password or PIN No. "0000".
- 5.) If prompted by your device to connect, select "Yes" (this will vary among devices)
- 6.) After successfully connecting, the blue LED will flash twice or three times every 4 seconds.

You should now be able to play music & make/receive calls using the headset. Hooray.

# BATTERY

## Charging the headset

The headset comes with a built-in rechargeable battery. It is recommended that you charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time. When the headset is low on power, a red LED flashes twice and the headset emits three "dong" tones every 30 seconds. Please recharge the battery of the headset when this happens.

## Using the USB cable

Plug the USB end of the cable into a computer USB port and the mini-USB end of the cable into the charging jack found on the right earpiece of the headset. The red LED light, also on the right earpiece, will come on while the headset is charging. It takes about 2 hours to charge the battery fully. When charging is completed, red LED will be off.




## Basic calling functionality

Function	Status of OT Bluetooth Tags	Operation
Cancel calling	Calling	Short press MFB button once
Answer a call	Incoming ring	Short press MFB button once
End a call	During a call	Short press MFB button once
Volume up	During a call	Short press + button
Volume down	During a call	Short press - button
Microphone mute	During a call	Double click MFB button
Cancel mute	During a call	Double click MFB button
Voice dial	Standby mode	Hold MFB button for 2 seconds

## Music playback functionality

Function	Status of OT Bluetooth Tags	Operation
Volume up	Playing music	Short press + button
Volume down	Playing music	Short press - button
Previous track	Playing music	Press and hold + for 2 seconds
Next track	Playing music	Press and hold - for 2 seconds
Pause	Playing music	Short press MFB button
Play	Pausing	Short press MFB button



## Twist & Clip

When you're not using the Tags, twist them up and clip them together. Wear them just like a pair of dog tags until you're ready to listen to music again. Or go to bed. Or, you know, lean over the fence at the alpaca exhibit.
