

Spot's Recommendation for using Belt Drive Systems in Off Road Conditions



While many belt drive riders will experience a quiet, long wearing, low maintenance drivetrain, there are some riding locales where certain types of dust and dirt can cause the belt to squeak. If you have a squeaking belt, here's what we recommend to quiet it.

Pedro's Slick Wax Premium Wax Lube

- Can be applied at any time— just before riding or days before
- Can be applied to a clean or dirty belt
- Shake well and apply generously to belt teeth and center groove along entire length of belt twice
- Apply between 50 and 100°F
- Let dry for 5-10 minutes prior to riding for best results

Other wax-type lubes may also work. Please follow the instructions on the lube, and be sure to allow adequate time to dry.



CRC Heavy Duty Silicone Spray

- Works best when applied immediately before riding, effects will be lessened if applied the night before
- Apply to a dirty belt— the dirt helps retain the lube
- Apply generously to belt teeth and center groove along entire length of belt
- Begin riding immediately while lube is still wet
