

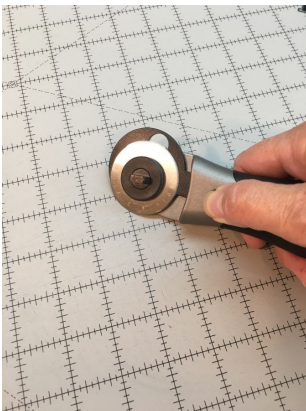
Quilters Select Rotary Cutter



Love this rotary cutter because of the weight and the nice ergonomic handle with the soft rubber on the sides.



When you want to open the blade press the button with your thumb and hold the button in the down position.

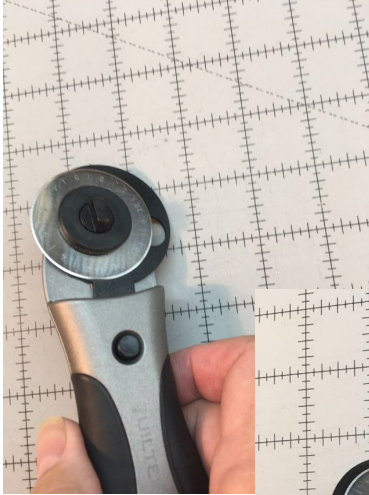


Now gently push the blade down on the cutting mat (still keeping the button pushed down) and the blade will be exposed. Release the button and the blade will stay locked in the exposed position.

I've learned that if you tip the handle over slightly to the right (while the button is pushed down) the guard will move up and expose a larger portion of the blade.



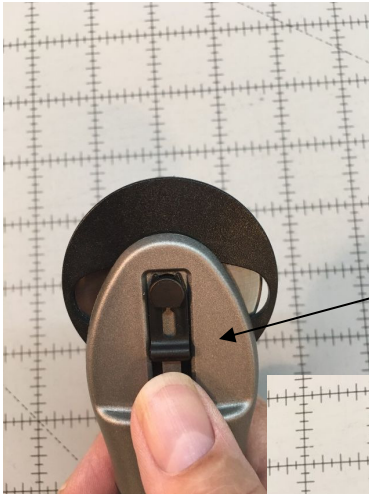
Now you're ready to cut!



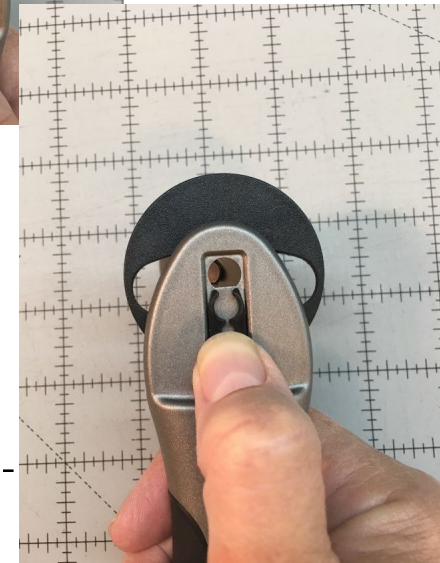
When you're ready to close the blade simply rotate the handle over to the right and lightly tap the guard.



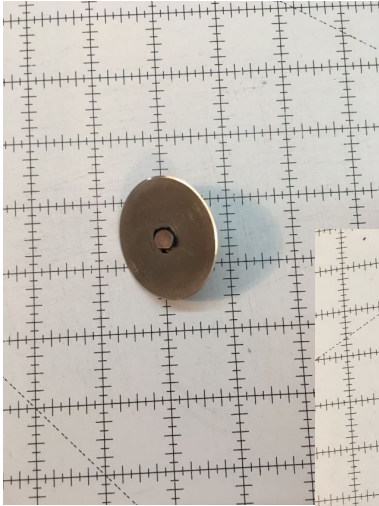
It should pop right back in place.



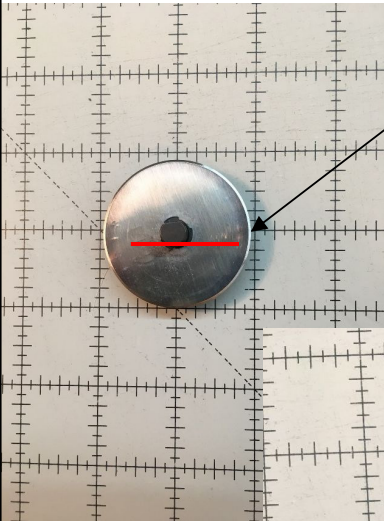
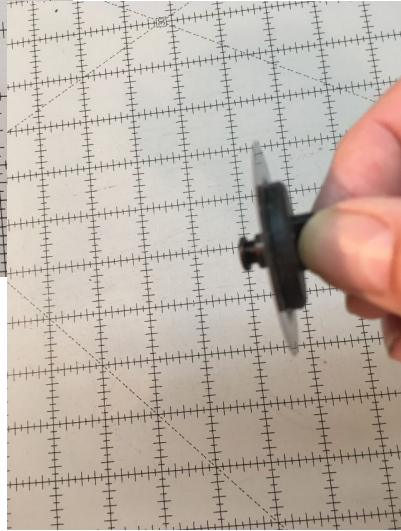
When it's time to change the blade it's EASY!!!
Flip the handle over. See the little ledge?????



Pull down on the ledge. The blade unit will drop out. Make sure you have your cutter very close to or touching your mat.

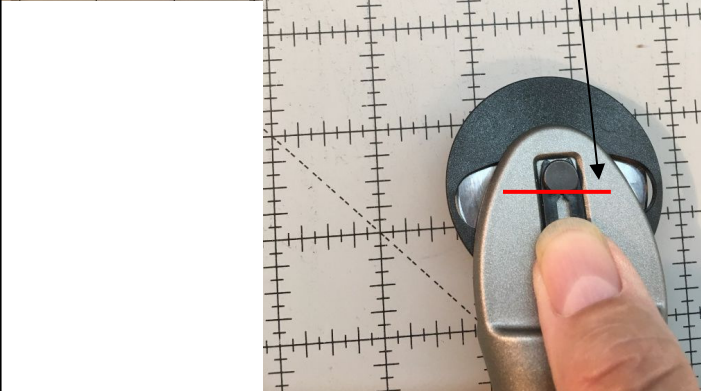


The blade handle is magnetized so it will hold your blade. Very cool!

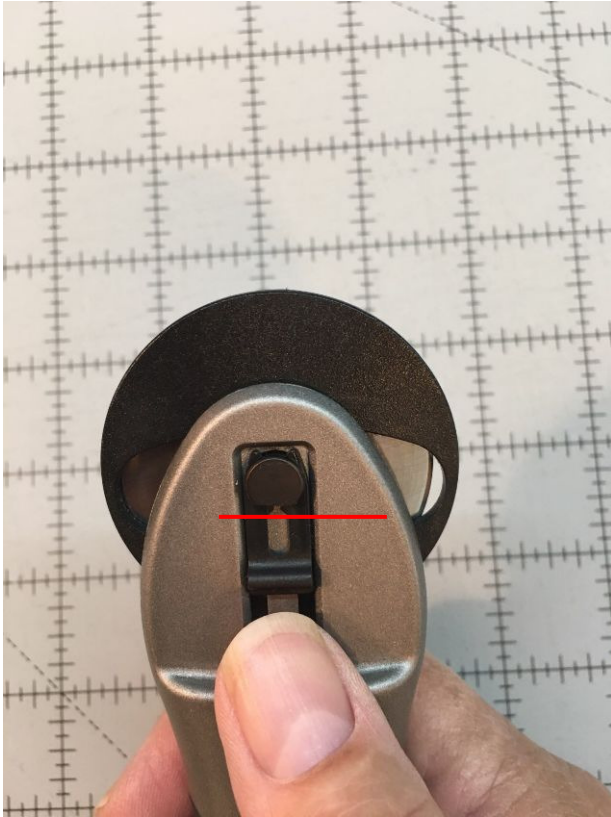


The blade handle has a flat edge.

The rotary cutter has a flat edge too.



Make sure these flat edges are lined up when you reattach the blade handle to the rotary cutter.



Now push the little ledge back into position. This locks the blade handle into place.



Now you're ready to get back to work!
