

Dear TeamO customer,

International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations;
27th Addition, published 2016, section 2.3.4.2.1 states that:

- Small cartridges fitted into a self-inflating lifejacket must be for inflation purposes
- No more than two small cylinders of carbon dioxide or another suitable non-flammable non-toxic gas fitted in the lifejacket per person can be carried onboard
- Maximum of two spare cartridges per person may be carried
- You are not allowed to carry more than one personal safety device per person

TeamO Marine confirms that lifejackets carrying the TeamO Marine brand label meet the IATA's Dangerous Goods Regulations (27th Addition, 2016, Section 2.3.4.2.1) rules that allow them to be carried as check in (hold) or carry-on luggage with the CO2 cylinder packed inside the lifejacket in the normal position. TeamO BackTow Lifejackets are packed in such a manner that it cannot be accidentally activated.

The CO2 cylinder inside the lifejacket meets the following specifications:

- Weight: our 170N lifejackets carry a 38g CO2 cylinder. The 275N lifejackets carry a 60g CO2 cylinder.
- Burst pressure: minimum 560 Bar
- Internal pressure: filled to 5,70MPa at 20 centigrade
