This online manufacturer offers a unique Air Suspension Management System which installs in less than thirty minutes and allows the owner to adjust suspension pressure without removing the saddlebag or side covers. With the EZ Air system installed, the rider can maximize rider comfort while minimizing the hassle of suspension adjustment.

Most Harley Touring Bike owners don't know how much pressure they have in the suspension. They always think the mechanic maintains the correct pressure when the motorcycle is serviced. That isn't the case. Suspension pressure is personal preference and needs to change as riding conditions change. Suspension pressure settings should be adjusted for motorcycle load (rider only, rider and passenger, rider and passenger with gear), road conditions, temperature changes, and tire wear. Another suspension pressure variable is leak rate. All Harley air suspensions leak and do so at an increased rate as pressure is increased. Most riders prefer their suspension pressure to be at 30 PSI or above. In order to maintain pressure at 40 – 50 PSI, the suspension needs to be checked daily.

The EZ Air product line consists of two models that will accommodate most Harley Davidson Electra Glides and Tri Glides 2009 and later. These units install in less than thirty minutes, require no special tools, online video tutorial support, and will not alter the original factory suspension circuit.
