Bundalong Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Selected from Quarry block Cabernet planted in 1990, with only the high rocky ground harvested through a berry sorter. Harvested on the 5th April 2019 at 14.0 baume, fermentation was for 10 days in a 10 tonne open top stainless steel fermenter.

Maturation was for 14 months in fine grained oak from Darnajou, Domaine Fouquet, Saury with 24% new oak.

Deep red with purple hue, the nose is rich with brooding dark cassis fruit plush and rounded, with some secondary aromas of bitumen and leather. A faint leafy note when swirled.

The palate is powerful and dense with black fruits and great shape with firm structured tannins. This wine will age well and reward careful cellaring.

An outstanding Cabernet from Bundalong from an excellent vintage.
