Selected from Quarry block Cabernet planted in 1990. This vineyard produces small crops of very small berries. The fruit was harvested and berry sorted in the field, then crushed and fermented in open topped stainless steel tanks for 8 days. The wine has dense red colour with fragrant aromas of small red berries, cassis and crushed vine leaf. The palate is fine and fine-grained with cassis fruit, leather and complex touch of earth. Drinking well now but will improve with further careful cellaring.
