FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do we start? Do we send you pictures to use as a reference? Do we just email them?

Yes! Emailing and/or providing links to your highest quality reference image(s) is the best way to get started and what I will use to create your commission. The higher quality the images, the more beauty and detail I can put into the artwork.

Do you paint, or draw, or what technique do you use?

I work in a range of art mediums: watercolor, acrylic, and oil paintings, as well as drawings in charcoal, pencil, pen and ink, and digital illustrations. I can work in a range of techniques and I have compiled many examples in the next few pages to present my personal style and quality of work. Dog portraits, sporting art, and wildlife are my specialty.

Once we email images to you, what happens next?

Before I ever begin your physical commission, I will typically photoshop a digital example of the composition that you've requested to make sure it's what we envision as the reference for the artwork (usually within a few days). Once you approve, I provide a final price quote and an emailed invoice link for the 50% reservation deposit required to get it on the commission schedule.

After we pay the deposit, how long does the process usually take?

Commissioned artwork begins in the order it is received, and only when the non-refundable reservation deposit of 50% has first been paid. I open certain parts of the calendar year to accept commissions. Currently, the estimated turnaround time is approximately 4-5 months, unless otherwise specified and approved. It is always a goal to accommodate special occasions and important dates if possible. Please note: turnaround time for paintings in oil may be significantly longer due to the nature of the medium's drying times.


When you complete our commission, then what?

Upon completion, and when the artwork's remaining balance is paid in full, the artwork is packaged and shipped with an accompanying certificate of authenticity to the specified address or can be arranged for you to pick up locally here in Auburn, Alabama.

Do you frame it for us?

Typically, no. Commissions are listed as unframed pieces as it reduces possibility for damages as well as cost in shipping. However, any framing included would be a separate, additional price quote and affects shipping rates, costs, and delivery time.



PROCESS & POLICY

- Pricing provided in this document is estimated as starting base rates regarding technique and size. Final pricing is subject to change based on composition details, sizing, technique, etc. (tax and shipping rates may also apply).
- Once a potential client's requested information, subject matter imagery, and composition have been arranged and agreed upon, finalized price quote is honored for 90 days unless otherwise specified and approved.
- Commissioned artwork begins in the order it is received, and only when the non-refundable reservation deposit of 50% has first been paid.

 Upon completion, the remaining 50% payment is due.
- In the case of larger/more complicated artwork with a significant project duration, it may be agreed upon that client agrees to pay final deposit in 2 increments of 25%—one at 75% completion and the remaining 25% at 100% completion for the finalized work of art.
- Currently the estimated delivery time is approximately 4-5 months, unless otherwise specified and approved. It is always a goal to accommodate special occasions and important dates if possible.
- Commissioned custom works of art are listed as unframed pieces.
 Any framing included would be a separate, additional price quote and affects shipping rates, costs, and delivery time.
