Register to Refer Patients to the Asian Smokers' Quitline



What is the Asian Smokers' Quitline (ASQ)?

• ASQ provides free, evidence-based cessation services in Mandarin, Cantonese, Korean and Vietnamese as well as free nicotine patches, sent to the smoker.

Why refer?

- Help Asian language smokers quit smoking to lead a healthier life!
- ASQ's evidence-based counseling has been shown to double the quit rate over self-help materials alone (published study, available by request).

Who can refer?

• Providers, pharmacists, community-based groups, faith-based groups, schools, employers, anyone may register to refer clients/patients to ASQ.

How to refer?

- 1. Go to: www.asiansmokersquitline.org
- 2. Hover your cursor over WEB REFERRAL
- 3. Register your organization by clicking on the **REGISTER YOUR ORGANIZATION** link
- 4. Wait for registration confirmation (within 2 business days)
- 5. After your registration is confirmed, click on **WEB REFERRAL** to begin referring smokers for ASQ services. ASQ will call smokers within 2 business days. All services are free, funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
