

AHAs

MANDELIC ACID

Mandelic Acid is in the family of AHA's that includes glycolic (sugar cane), lactic (sour milk), malic (apples), tartaric (grapes) and aromatic acids of mandelic (bitter almonds). They are predominantly favored for their powerful anti-aging and pigmentation lightening benefits. Mandelic acid is one of the larger molecules in the AHA family, making it appropriate for all skin types, including sensitive skin.

GLYCOLIC ACID

Glycolic acid is the smallest of the AHA family, and is both oil and water soluble, making it capable of efficient skin penetration and long-term skin rejuvenating benefits. Glycolic acid has an immediate effect for texture and skin discoloration improvements.

LACTIC ACID

Lactic acid is a hygroscopic acid that binds water. It has an immediate hydrating and plumping effect on skin. It also has a significant ability to inhibit melanin transfer from the melanocyte to the keratinocyte. This makes it the ideal peeling agent for aged skin experiencing lack of moisture, dehydration, and hyperpigmentation.

MALIC ACID

A powerful AHA that helps enhance the activity of other AHA's in a chemical peel blend while polishing the skin surface for an immediate, radiant glow.

MECHANISM OF ACTION

AHA's work by reacting with the upper layer of the epidermis, weakening the binding properties of the lipids that hold dead cells together, dissolving those cells to reveal underlying, smoother and more even skin. They are most efficient in solutions where the pH is lower than 3.0.

KOJIC ACID

Kojic acid is a universal skin brightener that inhibits melanin production in the melanocyte, and inhibits melanin transfer from the melanocyte to the keratinocyte. It has been clinically proven as more effective than hydroquinone in lightening skin discolorations.

LICORICE

Licorice is the perfect lightening partner for kojic acid with specific, targeted mechanisms of action at the melanocyte in the epidermis.

BEARBERRY

Bearberry helps licorice extract and kojic acid work better at targeting photodamage and skin discolorations.

VITAMIN C

Vitamin C targets free radical accumulation, collagen production, and visible surface discolorations. Synergistic combinations of these ingredients, blended with the right acids, give powerful results by enhancing skin penetration and biological activity.

There are significant benefits to combining chemical peels with CIT treatments. CIT creates controlled microchannels in skin, allowing for enhanced infusion of our combination peel treatments into skin, providing targeted results directly at the source of the skin problem. CIT can be used as a spot treatment for stubborn areas, or as a full-face enhancement to help improve the efficacy of our chemical peels.



HERBAL SKIN SOLUTIONS PEELS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Pre-treatment Instruction

- All patients should fill out and sign health history and consent forms provided by the clinic or spa.
- Prior to treatment, it is suggested that the provider offer a full consultation of expectations, possible side effects, benefits, post-care instructions, and treatment plan goals with their client. This process is referred to as the informed consent. Possible contraindications and photo-sensitizing medications should also be reviewed prior to treatment. Post-treatment client cooperation is vital.
- If patient has no contraindications and agrees to the treatment plan, you may proceed.
 Keep copies of all forms signed by the client for your records.
- Client should avoid direct sun exposure and tanning beds for at least 4 weeks pre and post treatment. SPF 30+ UVA/UVB Broad spectrum is recommended daily.
- Client should avoid waxing, Retin-A, chemical peels and harsh exfoliants 3-5 days prior to treatment.
- Client should avoid injections, fillers and Botox 2 weeks prior to treatment.
- Client should avoid microblading, permanent makeup procedures, IPL, laser or cosmetic surgeries at least 1 month prior to and following treatment.
- Client should avoid working out the day of treatment and days following until all redness and sensitivity completely subsides.
- If client is prone to Herpes Simplex/cold sores, you refer them to their medical care provider for an antiviral prescription to avoid any breakouts post treatment.
- Please note: A test patch performed behind the ear 24 hours prior to treatment to reduce the risk of adverse reactions is ideal.

During the Procedure:

It is important to note that while there is a recommended amount of time to leave the peel on skin, the peel should always be closely monitored, and removed immediately in the event of any suspected adverse reaction.

Please note: If customizing the Herbal Skin Solutions chemical peel with the addition of treatments such as dermaplaning or CIT treatment, the physical penetration of the peel is potentially accelerated, which means that the peel is going deeper and acting faster. It is recommended not to use these customization means for those having an HSS chemical peel for the first time. Please have neutralizer ready in the event of any adverse reaction that takes place from any of these customization options.



Remove the peel completely if:

- Hot spots occur
- Frosting or epidermolysis occurs
- Normal discomfort turns to moderate pain
- Moderate to severe swelling occurs
- Visible changes in skin pigmentation occur, either hyper- or hypo- pigmentation, or both simultaneously

When to neutralize the peel:

Peel should be neutralized by whichever occurs first:

- Maximum time limits of the peel
- Uniform, mild flushing on skin, which indicates the peel endpoint
- In the event of any adverse reactions listed above
- Strong to extreme discomfort exhibited by the client

To avoid potential complications when neutralizing, don't rub or abrade the skin. Use gentle rolling, patting motions.

**If an unexpected allergic response appears, neutralize and remove the peel immediately.

Contact a physician immediately.

What to expect post treatment:

- <u>Day 1:</u> Skin will be erythematous and flushed after treatment, depending on the intensity of treatment. The client may experience some flaking, but generally there is no peeling associated with Herbal Skin Solutions Professional Peels. Skin may feel tight and dry. Skin is sensitized to UVA/UVB rays.
- <u>Day 2:</u> A red or pink hue may persist like moderate sunburn. Skin may feel dry and tight. The treated area will be sensitized to UVA/UVB rays. Client may wear broad spectrum sunscreen w/ minimum SPF 30 and makeup (if needed) the following day.
- <u>Day 3:</u> Skin can be pink or normal color. The skin can feel dry and/or tight. A slight outbreak of acne or milia (tiny white bumps) is possible. Light flaking can occur in about three days and will be replaced with fresh new skin.

Contraindications for Chemical Peels

Avoid Chemical Peels in the following cases:

- Retinoid use within 3 days prior to the chemical peel. Using Herbal Skin Solutions Retinol
 is okay post-peel to enhance the peeling effects
- Herpes simplex virus
- Accutane use within 6 months
- Compromised skin, rosacea, eczema, or psoriasis is present
- Allergies to nuts or any other ingredient found in HSS peels

Mandelic 25% Pro-Glow Peel Protocol

pH 2.5

This versatile AHA peel can target multiple skin care concerns, such as uneven skin tone, post-inflammatory hyperpigmentation and breakouts. Mandelic acid is also considered safe for all Fitzpatrick types, and gentle enough for sensitive skin. Derived from bitter almonds, this gentle exfoliation treatment can improve skin texture and tone while providing antibacterial properties, making it ideal for oily and acne-prone skin.

About:

- Key Active Ingredient: Mandelic Acid 25%
- pH: 2.5
- Peel Depth: Very Superficial
- Treatment Time: 1-3 minutes
- <u>Treatment Frequency:</u> Series of 6, 10 days apart
- <u>Treatment Removal:</u> Neutralizer
- Can it be layered with other peels and treatments? Yes
- <u>Indications:</u> Rough tone and texture, dehydration, prep for microneedling treatments
- Fitzpatrick Types: All

Ingredients: Purified Water, SD Alcohol, Mandelic Acid, Propylene Glycol.

Prep:

- Take clear before photos in a designated area with consistent lighting at various angles and concentrating on areas of concern, such as hyperpigmentation, uneven texture, fine lines and wrinkles.
- Pre-cleanse using the Neroli Repair Oil followed by cleansing with the Hydrating Herbal Cleanser. Thoroughly cleanse the skin of all dirt, oil, makeup & debris. Remove with a lukewarm towel or disposable sponges.
 - *Microdermabrasion, Dermaplane and AnteAGE Regenzyme may be administered after cleansing as part of an enhanced exfoliation treatment (assuming these treatments alone and combined are considered within your scope of practice per your State Board of Regulation)
- Apply Professional Prep Solution to skin with a woven 4x4. Let skin dry completely.
- Using a cotton swab, apply a small amount of Vaseline or other occlusive to the inner and outer canthus of the eye, nasal openings, and the vermillion border.

Treat:

- Apply a thin, even veil of Mandelic 25% Pro-Glow Peel to a glycolic applicator and quickly apply evenly to the area being treated, in gentle, circular motions, avoiding over the eyelids, around the ears, corners of the nose and corners of the mouth.
- Mandelic 25% Pro-Glow Peel may be left on for 1-3 minutes depending on clients comfort level and skin condition. It is suggested in their first treatment to leave on for 1 minute and working up to 2-3 minutes in following sessions. Do not exceed 5 minutes with this peel.
 - *You can use a hand held fan over the treated skin after applying the peel to reduce client discomfort. The peel may feel "active" and tingly for some clients so it is important to check in with them often after the peel is applied to make sure they are comfortable.



<u>Neutralize:</u>

- Once you are ready to remove the peel, whether by time or clinical endpoint, rinse the skin with cold water. Next apply Neutralizer Solution evenly across the treated area. After neutralizing is complete, the client should not feel any discomfort.
 - *If hot spots appear, or extreme redness or stinging persists, wash the area being treated immediately and thoroughly with cold water. Pat the skin dry with cotton or tissue(no rubbing)
- After the peel has been neutralized completely, apply pH Balance toner to restore the skin's natural pH level.

<u>Immediately Post Treatment:</u>

- Remove gloves and take after photo in the same spot, same angles and same lighting as the before photos for comparison (this step is preferred before applying a tinted moisturizer so you can see the client's true complexion)
- Apply the Herbal Skin Solutions Vitamin C Enhancement Serum or EGF Cellular Activator, specific to skin type.
- Apply SPF 30 & Daily Tinted Moisturizer before client leaves the treatment room for protection against harmful UVA/UVB rays.
 - *A hat, scarf, clean sunglasses and/ or solar shield visor may also be worn prior to client leaving the treatment room during daytime hours for extra sun protection.
- Provide client with home care products based on their specific concerns.

- Ensure your microneedling pen has a full battery and place protective sleeve over your device. Set CIT Pen to 0.25mm before inserting your cartridge. Choose Nano Silicone or Nano Surgical Steel disposable cartridge, depending on client's desired results. With top of pen facing upward, insert sterile Nano cartridge spiral side down, until the cartridge is flush with the device. Once the cartridge is flush, twist clockwise until you feel the grooves interlocking into place. Be sure cartridge is fully secure with no wiggle room. This will ensure it does not pop off during treatment. Place your protective sleeve over your device. To power your device on, hold the power button down for 2-3 seconds until you feel your device power up. Press power button once to change through the various speed settings.

Prep:

- Take clear before photos in a designated area with consistent lighting at various angles
 and concentrating on areas of concern, such as hyperpigmentation, uneven texture, fine
 lines and wrinkles.
- Pre cleanse using the Neroli Repair Oil followed by cleansing with the Hydrating Herbal Cleanser. Thoroughly cleanse the skin of all dirt, oil, makeup & debris. Remove with a luke warm towel or disposable sponges.
 - *Microdermabrasion, Dermaplane and AnteAGE Regenzyme may be administered after cleansing as part of an enhanced exfoliation treatment (assuming these treatments alone and combined are considered within your scope of practice per your State Board of Regulation)
- Apply Professional Prep Solution to skin with a woven 4x4. Let skin dry completely.
- Using a cotton swab, apply a small amount of Vaseline or other occlusive to the inner and outer canthus of the eye, nasal openings, and the vermillion border. Treat: Apply Pro-Glow Peel 55% to a glycolic applicator and quickly apply evenly to the area being treated, in gentle circular motions.
- Pro-Glow Peel may be left on for 1-3 minutes depending on clients comfort level and skin condition. It is suggested in their first treatment to leave on for 1 minute and working up to 2-3 minutes in following sessions. Do not leave this peel on for more than 5 minutes.
 - *You can use a hand held fan over the treated skin after applying the peel to reduce client discomfort. The peel may feel "active" and tingly for some clients so it is important to check in with them often after the peel is applied to make sure they are comfortable.



Neutralize and Remove:

- Once you are ready to remove the peel, whether by time or clinical endpoint, rinse the skin with cold water. Next apply Neutralizer Solution evenly across the treated area. After neutralizing is complete, the client should not feel any discomfort.
 - *If extreme redness or stinging persists, wash the area being treated immediately and thoroughly with cold water. Pat the skin dry with cotton or tissue (no rubbing).
- After the peel has been neutralized completely, apply pH Balance toner to restore the skin's natural pH level.

<u>Immediately Post-Treatment:</u>

- Remove gloves and take after photo in the same spot, same angles and same lighting as
 the before photos for comparison (this step is preferred before applying a tinted
 moisturizer so you can see the clients true complexion).
- Apply your choice of corrective serum. We recommend the Herbal Skin Solutions Vitamin C Enhancement Serum or EGF Cellular Activator.
- With gloves, apply SPF 30 & Daily Tinted Moisturizer before client leaves the treatment room for protection against harmful UVA/UVB rays.
 - *A hat, scarf, clean sunglasses and/ or or solar shield visor may also be worn prior to client leaving the treatment room during daytime hours for extra sun protection.
- Provide client with home care products based on their specific concerns.
