So they leaned towards whites and gray colors only. Secondly their raft rides were abrading the sides of the slide walls in less than a year.

The picture below shows a bright color that typically fades fast but after one year the area looked like it was just applied. The system still had a high tile gloss and was not attacked by UV, chlorinated water or the abuse and wear of the tubes used on this ride
