

- 1. What is Essentials of the English Language Curriculum, Fifth Edition?
  - a. Essentials of the English Language Curriculum, Fifth Edition [Essentials Curriculum, Fifth Edition] is a twenty-four-week English grammar curriculum that will help your students excel when learning literature, writing, and foreign languages.   - a. The Essentials program is intended for students ages 9–12, though the grammar concepts are helpful for anyone looking to reclaim his or her education.

  - a. This curriculum is used in the Essentials program.
