### MLA STYLE

#### History Cards

“Card title.” [Card #]. *Classical Acts Facts® History Cards: Set Name*. West End, NC: Classical Conversations MultiMedia, 2012.

Example:

“Spanish Conquistadors in the Americas.” [Card 95]. *Classical Acts & Facts® History Cards: New World*. West End, NC: Classical Conversations MultiMedia, 2012.

#### For Science Cards

Example:
