# FAQ for Math in Motion

#### When will it be available?

### Can students use the first edition?

The content in the second edition has been simplified and reorganized in order to facilitate learning. In addition, this edition provides clearer explanations and streamlined assignments to make it easier to understand, so we do not recommend that people use the first edition.

## Can families use the answer key for the first edition with the second edition textbook?

The first edition answer key does not align with the second edition. Many of the exercises have been revised or have changed position in the book, so there is not a good correlation between the first edition answer key and the second edition book. Therefore, we do not recommend that families use the first edition answer key with the second edition textbook.

## How can I prepare while I wait for my book to arrive?

A series of tutorials is available on CC Connected and on Learning Pathways. These chapter-bychapter explanations are highly recommended throughout the course, especially for the nonmusician, and they are also a great way to prepare in advance of receiving the book.

### Can students share books?

The answer key can be shared by several members of the same family. However, since the textbook is consumable, each student and director needs his or her own copy.

### Who will use this resource?

Challenge III students will use this resource in the Reasoning strand.

### Does the new resource replace an existing resource?

Math in Motion replaces Traditional Logic II and Meno in Challenge III.
