Marsh Bellofram is issuing this memorandum as a notice to our distributors/reps/customers regarding California Proposition 65.

**California Proposition 65**

California Proposition 65 (Prop 65) is the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. Prop 65 requires businesses to provide a "clear and reasonable" warning to the people of California in regards to chemicals, which Prop 65 has identified, as having a potential to cause cancer, birth defects or reproductive harm.

- Prop 65 requires suppliers to:
  - Identify chemicals, from the hazardous chemical list, which have the potential to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
  - If applicable, list at least one chemical which causes cancer and/or reproductive harm.
  - Or provide a short form warning on the product which details the specific type of harm and labels it correctly per 27 CCR 25603 (b) of the California Code of Regulations.

As a distributor/rep/customer of Marsh Bellofram, we are informing you of your duties under California Proposition 65.


- You must provide a copy of the warning to your customers in California. This warning can be found on the order acknowledgement.
  - This warning will start to appear on order acknowledgements by August 30, 2018.
  - For units currently in your possession manufactured prior to August 30, 2018 please provide this warning.
- Any internet sales must also contain this warning prior to or during the course of the purchase of units.

Marsh Bellofram believes the amount of one or more of these chemicals is minimal but cannot guarantee that the levels are below the limits required by the State of California. Marsh Bellofram will not test the level of every chemical listed in Proposition 65 in any of the wide range of our products.

Please confirm your acknowledgement and willingness to comply with the requirements we request of Prop 65, electronically or in writing. Contact Marsh Bellofram with any questions or concerns in regards to our requests for additional information.
