YOUR WINE CLUB ONLINE ACCOUNT

As a Wine Club Member, you have access to the 1830 Club Members-Only Area of the website. Use this area for all your wine club orders, as it will give you access to your free postage, and other member discounts and benefits. The first time you use the Members-Only Area on the website, you will need to set up your password.

We will send you a welcome email to the address you gave us when you joined, and this will have more information on how to set up your account. If you do not see the email in the coming week, please check your junk folder. If it still does not arrive, please get in touch as it may mean that we have entered your email address incorrectly. We will communicate with you about the next Wine Club order by email, so it is important that the club emails arrive safely with you. If you would prefer to be contacted by phone each order time, please do not hesitate to let us know.

YOUR NEXT CLUB MAIL-OUT

Mail-out times for the 1830 Club happen in June and late November each year. There are also mail-outs in March and September for anyone who prefers four 6-bottle packs a year. You are welcome to order at any time during the year.

When you receive your order email you have the chance to choose your own wines. Hop online and make your own selection. If we do not hear from you within 7 days, we will automatically post you out the Wine Club Pack for that order. The pack will be detailed in your order email, and on the website. The pack will be a mix of Bangor Wines.

If you would like to order your wines at other times, you are more than welcome, and we will count them against your 24-bottles each year.

THE STORY BEHIND THE NAME

The 1830 Wine Club has been named in honour of John Dunbabin, a tenant farmer from the Bangor region of Wales who was convicted of horse stealing, and was transported to Van Diemen's Land, arriving in Hobart Town, December 1830. Having narrowly escaped the hangman's noose, he was determined to make the most of his opportunities. Through sheer hard work, John earned his freedom and bought his own land, paving the way for seven generations of farming by the Dunbabin family in Tasmania, and five generations of farming at Bangor.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND FAQ ABOUT THE CLUB

By joining the 1830 Wine club you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- Choose any mix of Bangor's wines. For the museum wines, there are restrictions on the number of bottles that can be purchased per member. Our range of available wines changes from season to season.
- Members are entitled to a 5% discount on all wine purchased through the wine club, online store and in Bangor Vineyard Shed, and a 5% discount on meals and wine at Bangor Vineyard Shed (applied to the first 4 people in your group).
- Select your first mix of 12 Bangor Wines when you first join the club. We will post these out to you free of charge. We will be in contact via email with information about the Club, and about how to register for the Wine Club Members Area of the Bangor Website.
- If you prefer to receive your Wine Club information by telephone, please let us know by calling Vanessa (0418 594 362) or by email: wineclub@bangorshed.com.au.
- By joining you are ordering a case of wine (12 bottles of wine), and thereafter a case of wine in every subsequent half yearly (or quarterly) release date until cancellation under these terms. You are agreeing to a minimum 24 bottle purchase.
- We will contact you by email to confirm your next selection. Choose your own selection of wines when we email you. If we don't hear from you within 7 days, you will be automatically posted the wine club pack for that order and your credit card deducted.
- Members may cancel their order at any time by written notice only, but such cancellation will only take effect after you have purchased a minimum of 24 bottles. Unsubscribing from the email list does not unsubscribe you from the Wine Club.
- Freight is complementary for all Wine Club members. Delivery of wine is taken to have occurred to you on dispatch to the courier from our cellar.
- Members are entitled to free standard wine tasting in Bangor Shed's private wine room any time. During business hours. Free for 2 people. Appointments not necessary, but we do recommend bookings on weekends and public holidays. Call Bangor Shed on (03)62 535 558.
- By registering as a Wine Club member, you:
 - authorise us to debit you nominated credit card, or replacement card with the cost of your wine deliveries as they occur half yearly (or quarterly), and in that regard, we may debit your card on the day of release of the relevant half yearly (or quarterly) wine series (7 days after email notification to you);
 - acknowledge that you will automatically receive your wine deliveries half yearly (or quarterly);
 - acknowledge that you may only cancel your half yearly wine deliveries after your first 24 bottles have been purchased; and
 - acknowledge that we may keep your credit card details securely on file.
- Members are obliged to notify Bangor of any change to delivery address or credit card details.
- Members must be 18 years of age or older.
- Bangor complies with the requirements of the Privacy Act 1988 as amended.
- You give Bangor permission to contact you via mail/phone/email.
- Bangor reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions.
