When enrolled, you will receive a message on your Nest thermostat or app to inform you of upcoming cycling events.

Prior to an AC Cycling Smart Thermostat event, we may automatically adjust temperatures to pre-cool your home to a comfortable setting.

If you don't have a Nest Thermostat but still want to participate in AC Cycling,

ComEd can install a Direct Load Control Switch on your air conditioner's compressor that allows us to cycle your air for you.

Your fan will stay on to circulate already cooled air keeping your

home comfortable.

With the Direct Load option, you can choose to participate at fifty percent or one hundred percent.

At fifty percent, you can earn up to twenty dollars in bill credits each year.

And at one hundred percent, you can earn up to forty dollars in bill credits each year.
