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Product Review: Nail Aid 10x Strength Collagen Nail Builder



About 2 weeks ago I was shopping at Ross and I found this product in a bin near the check out counters with some other nail polish and cosmetic items. I have been a home pedicure aficionado for a while now, but I recently started painting my fingernails as well. When I started doing so, I noticed that my nails are very soft, flexible and prone peeling, cracking, splitting and tearing. The softness of my nails seemed to make keeping a manicure for more than 2-3 days difficult because when my nails bend a lot it causes my polish to peel and

chip.

The instructions on the back of the box say that for best results you should use this product alone, applying 1-2 coats every 3 days, or if you use it with nail polish, use it as your base coat and your top coat. I have been using it with my nail polish. I've used it twice, and I can already tell a difference in the strength of my nails. They are less flexible and have not been peeling, cracking, splitting or tearing.

I can definitely say I would recommend this product. I found it for a lot cheaper than some of the other popular brands like Sally Hansen. I think I paid \$3.99 for it at Ross. If you have used this product, please feel free to share your experience in the comments.

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
