
This is time of year when I start thinking about getting my skin ready for Summer. I tend to slack off on certain routines during the Winter when I'm not showing a lot of skin and then I usually have to work overtime to get them back into shape...especially my feet. You would think it'd just be easier for me to maintain them all Winter long, but nope, when the cold weather hits, I get lazy.

I own several electric foot filing devices...the Amope Pedi Perfect, Emjoi Micro Pedi, Ped Egg Power, and even have the foot filing brush for my Clarisonic. They all do their part to help shave off calluses and dead, dry skin but they don't always get it all, especially the rough skin on the tops of my feet which are too sensitive to use those devices on.

I've used foot peels in the past, such as **Philosophy's Soul Owner** (\$16) and Bath and Body Works **True Blue Spa Heel Of Appproval** (\$15) but I've struggled with finding a less expensive drugstore version that contains a high amount of glycolic acid...most drugstore foot creams I see are hydrating but don't exfoliate those dead skin cells away. Last week, I was in Walmart checking out the new Hard Candy Spring 2015 products and stumbled upon some new products from Nail-Aid, including this Pedi Express 3-Minute Pedi Peel. I can't remember the exact price, but I believe it was \$4-something...definitely under \$5.



softens dry, callused skin without the need for filing. So I grabbed one...and apparently everyone else did too. I went back a few days later and these were all gone from the shelf already!



are the smallest of all the AHA's so it can penetrate further into the skin than fruit or milk acids. It basically acts as tiny Pac-Men eating away and dissolving the sebum and other substances that make cells clump together on the surface and build up. It's relatively gentle...I've never had any irritation from using it but it can make your skin more sun sensitive since it's removing the top layer, so please keep that in mind.

DIRECTIONS: Apply a generous amount to feet & let absorb at least 3-5 minutes. Do not rinse. For softest feet next morning, use at bedtime. Testing is recommended for sensitive skin.







dry with some rough patches, this cream is strong enough to do the trick! Either way, I


