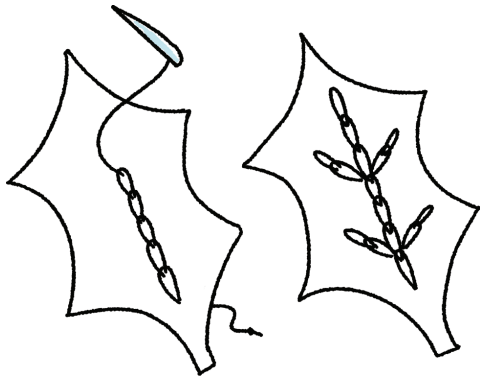


How to Make a Holly Ornament

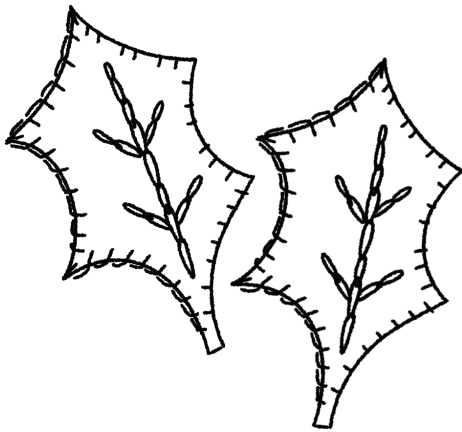
- 1** Take one of your leaf pieces and chain stitch a line down the middle using a different shade of green than your felt. Add extra “links” to the sides to add detail to your leaf. Repeat with another of your leaf pieces; you have two stitched leaves and two plain.



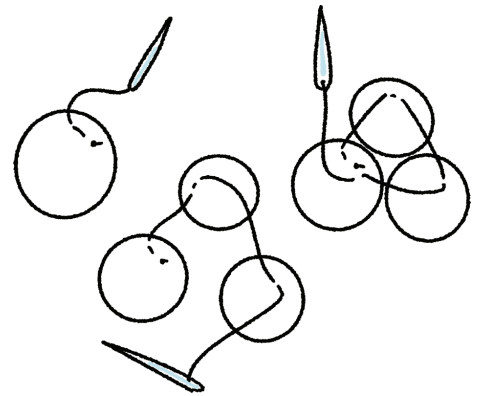
- 2** Place one stitched leaf on top of a plain leaf. Blanket stitch around your edge to sew them together.



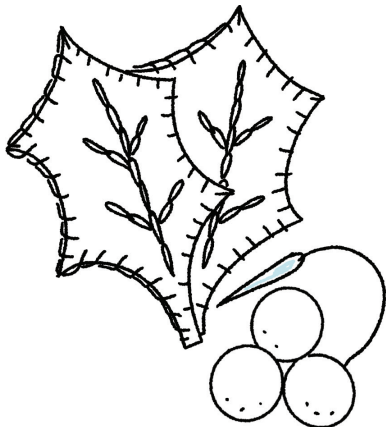
- 3** Repeat with your remaining leaf pieces; you now have two stitched together leaves.



- 4** Using red embroidery floss, make a small stitch through each of your felt balls—you will have all three on the same thread. Bring your needle back to your first ball and make another stitch, joining them together in a triangle shape.



- 5** Position your leaves at an angle, one on top of the other. Stitch your ball triangle onto your leaves, then tie off.



- 6** Using floss or twine, stitch a loop to the top of one of your leaves for hanging.
