PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

SETTING UP YOUR QOD

- The same three locking mechanisms keep the QOD locked in position while it is upright and when it is folded. Two of these are levers located at the end of each arm. The other is a rotating knob in the center of the spine, which allows you to raise the spine when ready to play, and lower it when finished.
- There are four steps to expanding and collapsing the bottom base of your QOD. These include extending the front wheels forward, widening the front wheels outward, lowering the bottom bag support down and then raising its bracket with bungee extensions upward.
- The easiest way to learn this is to watch the video at QODGOLFUSA.COM/SETUP
 We recommend practicing this until it is easily repeatable before heading to the course.

OPERATION

- Handle your QOD with caution and care and it will lead you down the fairway for years to come. Always walk with your hand on the cart or within arm's reach to make stopping, turning, and supporting it on slopes or bumpy terrain more convenient.
- There is no brake on the QOD. You simply stop the cart on a level surface or find an angle to leave the cart parked across the slope.
- Your wheels are pre-aligned to track in a straight line. However, if after using the QOD you need to make an adjustment, please watch the video at QODGOLFUSA.COM/ALIGNMENT

BATTERY

Battery Power Lights

Green, Yellow, and Red Lights ON = More than 50% battery power.

Only Yellow and Red Lights ON = Less than 50% battery power.

Only Red Light ON = Less than 10% battery power.

Advance Cart -

10, 20, or 30 seconds and it will stop on its own.

Power On/Off -

Leave on throughout round.



Potentiometer Knob

Roll forward or backward to adjust your speed. Use as an alternative to + or - buttons. Do not leave knob in ON position while using + or - buttons.

Speed Settings

Use + or - buttons to adjust between nine settings.

Do not use + or - buttons while potentiometer knob is in ON position.

Start and Stop Button

Rest your thumb on the button and press once to start and once to stop.
