Supplies needed for class:

- Book: There's More Than One Way to Bind a Quilt
- 4 fat quarters
- 2 pieces of batting 18 x 22.
(Not lofty. Any sold at Calico Gals is fine.)
- Clover Awl
- Assorted fabrics for binding strips (see homework notes below)
- Scissors and Pins
- Wonder Clips
- 2 spools of thread (one to match quilt back and one to match accent fabric - consider grey if you are undecided)

Receive a 15% discount at Calico Gals on all supplies purchased for class.

Leave your machine at home!

In the "new" Studio Classroom at Calico Gals, machines and design walls are provided. You will receive instruction on winding the bobbin and machine operation in class.

Let's all be safe!

Each student will have their own tables and plenty of room to social distance.

Homework before class begins:

- Make one quilt sandwich from two fat quarters and batting. Quilt this sandwich with walking foot or free motion. We will trim in class for two samples.
- 2. Cut 10' x 10" piece of top fabric and batting. Cut backing 15" x 15". Lay backing fabric right side down on the table. Center batting and top fabric (right sides up) on the backing. Secure with safety pins. Quilt as desired as simple as possible. Walking foot is just fine. This will become the sample for the self binding.
- 3. Cut binding strips for French fold binding. Cut 3 strips WOF x 2.5". We will join in class.
- 4. Cut binding strips for flange binding. You will need two fabrics. One fabric will contrast with the other. Cut one strip 1-1/4" x WOF and one strip 1-1/2" x WOF. The strip that is the widest will become the contrast and show the most against the quilt sandwich.
