To identify the difference between NEMA 5-20 and the NEMA 6-20 male plugs is to look at them head on with the grounding pin toward to the top. If the horizontal pin is on the left side, that is NEMA 5-20P. If it is on the right side, it is NEMA 6-20P. For an outlet or female connector, look at it with the grounding pin towards the top again. This time, the horizontal pin will be flipped. So NEMA 6-20R it will be on the left and NEMA 5-20R it will be on the right. Male Plug Male Plug
