Severe Spring Weather in the U.S.

Severe storms are a regular Spring season problem we have to deal with. Tornado season in the U.S. starts in February and runs through November each year. This year severe weather started popping up already in January. AccuWeather says, the average number of Tornadoes in the U.S. in January is 35 and in February is 29.

This year started with 90 tornadoes in January and quickly turned into a deadly season. Dozens of people lost their lives this year to tornadoes already. The most notable being in early March in Tennessee. There was also a deadly tornado outbreak in the south in early April.

The peak of tornado season is April, May, and June. Already the month of April was the most active since 2011 and the deadliest month on record since May 2013. Although we have had a pretty calm May so far things are expected to heat up and the weather patterns could shift and become more severe in the plains rather than in the south, where it has been so far this year.

Either direction the extreme weather patterns decide to take, one thing we can be sure about is the danger to us and the need for emergency power. This month's focus will be on emergency power and severe weather safety. It is our goal to help you be as prepared as you can during a severe weather outbreak.

Dryers require 220 Volt power and 30 Amps. It is impossible for them to operate using regular household outlets.

Regular household outlets only provides 110 Volts with up to 15 or 20 Amps.

You cannot adapt your dryer to work by using a regular household outlet.

CarGenerator™ and AC WORKS®

Working together to bring you emergency power.

You may have heard of CarGenerator™ before, either in one of our posts or YouTube videos, or somewhere else. CarGenerator™ is a small backpack sized case that can power your home using your car. If you have never heard of the CarGenerator™ before, you can learn more here.

Alongside the CarGenerator™ you will need an extension cord and possibly some adapters to help you get the power from your vehicle to your home. AC WORKS® has some products to help.

If you have an inlet box installed you may need an adapter. The most common inlet box types are the SS2-50 and the L14-30. The SS2-50 requires the AC WORKS® RV515SS2 or ADTE515 adapters. The L14-30 requires the AD515L1430 adapter. You can plug these adapters into your inlet box and then use a heavy-duty household extension cord, like the S515PR-120AL indoor/outdoor cord.

If you don't have an inlet box installed you will have to rely on power distribution to get power from the CarGenerator™ to your home. We have PDU products like the PSROT-072 rotating power strip, the ADV104 one to two outlet PDU, S515B515-60 power strip cord with power indicator. These products should be used inside the home, connected to your CarGenerator™ using our indoor/outdoor heavy-duty extension cord. FREQUENT FEATURE

S515L520-012 will not work with a NEMA 10-30P 3-Prong dryer plug. Although the L5-20R connector vaguely looks like the 3-Prong dryer connection, remember the size difference. L5-20R is roughly the same size as your household connector whereas the 10-30P is almost the size of the palm of your hand.

The L5-20R is typically used for server rack power strips, pumps, and small power tools. The 10-30P 3-Prong dryer plug is typically only used with dryers.
