#### **TIPS FROM TONY**

One of the trickiest things to identify is the alignment of a NEMA 5-20 plug and connector. When you look at the plug with the ground facing up, the horizontal pin will be on the left, with the vertical pin on the right. When looking at the connector side, they will be flipped. When you need to plug something in to an outlet, the plug will need to flip to go into the terminals in the receptacle.
