### 2021 Hurricane Season Predictions

Hurricane season officially begins on June 1, 2021, and lasts through the end of November. The last few hurricane seasons have been very active and predictions are the same for this year in the Atlantic. AccuWeather predicts that Florida may not be as fortunate as they were last season. The Bermuda High, a high-pressure system, pushed many of the storms to the south of Florida last year. The high has weakened which is causing the prediction for Florida. The AccuWeather forecasters are predicting 16-20 named storms, with 7-10 of them being hurricanes and 3-4 of them at or above Category 3. The National Hurricane Center is planning to start forecasting in mid-May this year, based on previous years having storms before the June start of the season.

This is an AC WORKS® brand compact dryer adapter. This adapter has a NEMA 14-30P, 4-Prong, NEW dryer plug connecting to a 3-Prong, NEMA 10-30R OLD dryer outlet. In other words, this adapter helps connect the old-style, 3-prong, dryer plug to the new style, 4-prong, dryer outlet, in newer homes. This adapter also comes with a grounding cable allowing you to ground your dryer for safety.

- NEMA 14-30P, 4-Prong NEW Dryer Plug
- NEMA 10-30R, 30 Amp OLD Dryer Power Source Outlet (Connector)
- NEMA 14-30P to 10-30R Dryer Compact Adapter

## TIPS FROM TONY

Our CBF520 adapters have two sets of 20A circuit breakers. This means 20A per duplex outlet on the female end of the adapter. Another way to think of this is to use the NEMA 5-20 household outlets you have at home as an example. Those outlets are 20A per duplex, not per outlet. The same applies here with 20A per set of duplex outlets.

This AC WORKS® dryer adapter is 1.5ft in length. It has a NEMA 10-30P 3-prong dryer plug, usually seen in older home's dryer outlets, connecting to NEMA 14-30R, 4-prong female outlet used with a new dryer plug. The cable is a STW, 10/3, 30 Amp copper wire with a 600 Volt anti-cold weather jacket.

How do you save on your electric bill? Here are some tips.

- Air drying your dishes in the dishwasher can reduce its energy use up to 50%.
- Start with your ceiling fan when trying to lower the temperature in your home on a warm day.
- LED lighting reduces energy use and lasts longer.
- Use motion detectors to turn lights on as they detect motion and then the lights turn off automatically when there is no motion detected.
- Do not open your oven when cooking, opening the oven lowers the temp and requires more energy consumption to reheat to the temperature you need.
- Use a microwave or toaster oven instead of the oven to heat food.
- Use smart plugs, allowing you to turn electronics on and off when not in use.
- Use a programmable thermostat to change temperatures when not in the home.
- Use cold water when washing clothes to avoid using the energy required to heat the water, which is most of the energy used by your washing machine.
- Keep your dryer clean so it does not have to work so hard.
- Upgrade your dryer because old dryers waste 20% more energy.

## NEW PRODUCT RELEASE

### *SS2CBF520 and SS2CB520*

AC WORKS® has brought you two new protective power adapters. The power source for these adapters is a 50 Amp outlet. The concern about this by many of our customers is that the outlet will carry too much power to their equipment causing it to burn out. The solution we came up with is the addition of the 20 Amp breaker. The breaker helps to reduce people's concerns about a power overload to their equipment by only allowing the necessary 20 Amps of power through the adapter. We have two adapters to offer our customers. The SS2CB520, which is a heavy-duty industrial cable. This 1.5-foot adapter offers a NEMA SS2-50P to NEMA 5-15/20R. The NEMA SS2-50P is a 50 Amp, 4-prong marine/industrial power distributor plug. The NEMA 5-15/20R is a 15/20 Amp, T-blade female household connector. Then we have the SS2CBF520 protective power strip cord. The cord is 1.5-feet in length and is a NEMA SS2-50P/ CS6365 to four NEMA 5-15/20R outlets. The NEMA SS2-50P is a 50 Amp, 125/250 Volt locking plug. The NEMA 5-15/20R is a 20 Amp, 125 Volt, T-blade household female connector.
