FREQUENT FEATURE

NEMA L14-20 and NEMA L14-30 are a couple of configurations that get confused the most. Although they look somewhat similar, there is a distinct tell that sets them apart: the grounding pin. For both a plug and connector, the NEMA L14-20 ground pin has a notch that sticks up. For NEMA L14-30 plugs and connectors, it goes the opposite way and sticks inwards.

The direction does not change between plugs and connectors for both of these configurations.
