

Thanks for choosing our Wall Art Stickers.

These instructions will guide you through the application process quickly and easily. Please read completely before you start.

Your wall art vinyls, arrive to you in three layers.

- The top layer is the application tape.
- The middle layer is the vinyl graphic.
- The bottom layer is the printed backing paper.

NB. These graphics are recommended for any smooth flat surface: glass, metals, vehicles, hard plastics, fibreglass, painted wood, other painted surfaces.

Please allow freshly painted surfaces to dry for at least two weeks.


Tools required:

Squeegee (supplied).
Low tack masking tape.

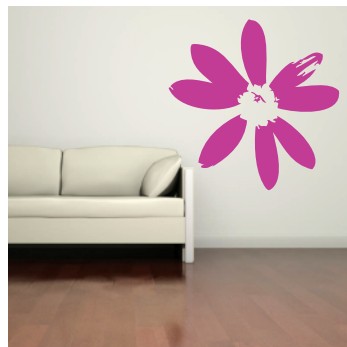
Please proceed as follows:

1. Ensure the surface you are applying to is clean, dry, sound and clear of dust and grease.

2. **On a flat table, with the application tape side up, use your squeegee to wipe over the whole graphic using plenty of pressure.** This will help stick the vinyl to the application tape and release it from the backing paper at a later stage.

 3. Plan your design first. If you are going to overlap your 'stickers' make sure you stick the background element on first, working your way to the foreground.

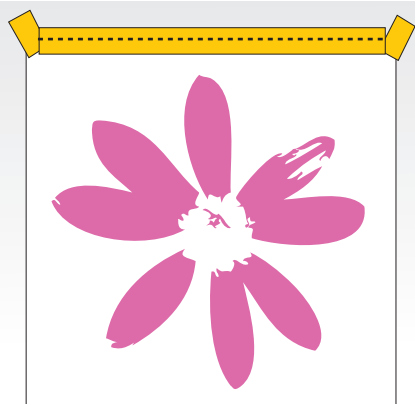
3a. Place the sticker in position, with printed paper backing sheet against the surface you are fixing to, using small tags of low tack masking tape. Once in position secure with a full length strip of tape to form a hinge along the top edge.



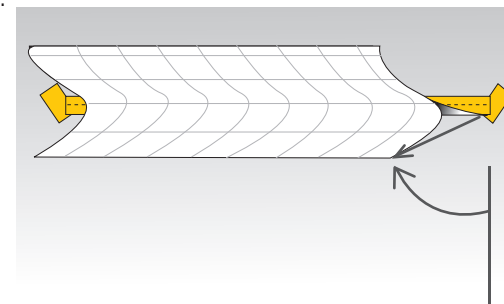
 **Please be aware lighter colours are not totally opaque when overlaid on darker colours.**

USEFUL TIP...You may find that for smaller size wall stickers it is not necessary to use instruction 3. 4.

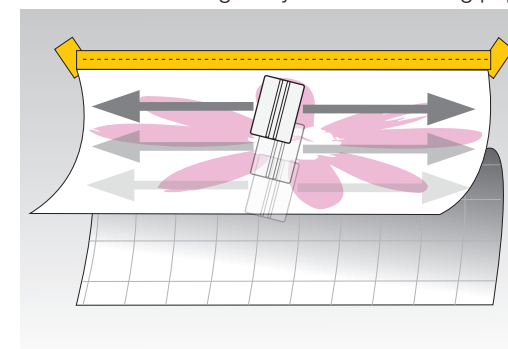
Instead simply peel the backing paper away from the front graphic, carefully place sticker in position and squeegee as in instruction 5.



4. Lift the graphic from the bottom, peel back a small section from the top of the backing paper. Holding the base of the graphic, allow it to return to its original position, taking care not to allow the revealed section to stick to the surface. **(On larger graphics it may be useful to have someone help you with this step).**



5. Using the squeegee and light pressure, start from the top centre and with horizontal strokes apply the vinyl. Always stroke from the centre out to the edges. Carry on this way removing sections of backing as you progress down the graphic. Checking that the sticker is coming away from the backing paper.



6. When the sticker is in place and backing paper is removed, resqueegee the graphic with firm pressure, paying particular attention to the edges.

7. **Leave for ten minutes.**

8. Slowly remove the application tape at a 180° angle back over itself.

9. Finally remove any air bubbles by puncturing the bubble at one edge with a pin.
