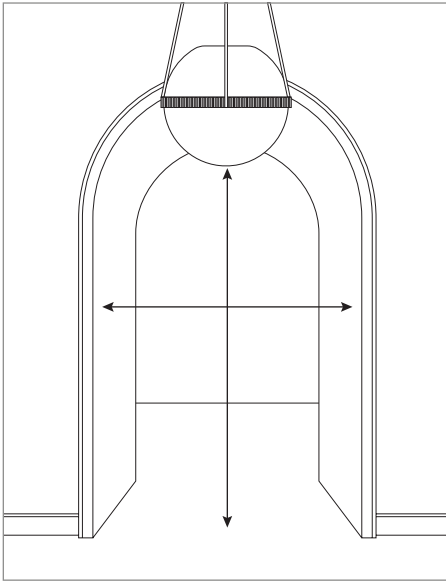


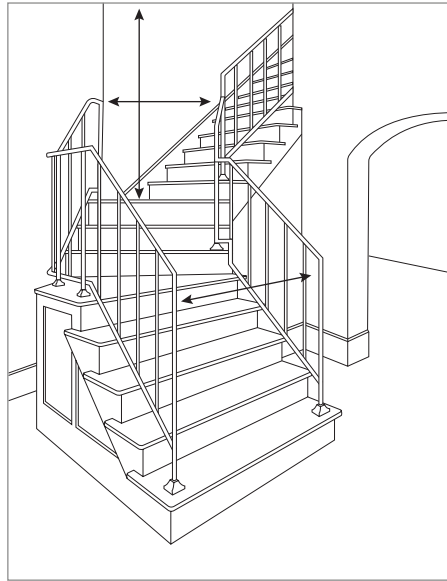
# How to Measure and Prepare for Furniture Delivery

## Pre-Delivery



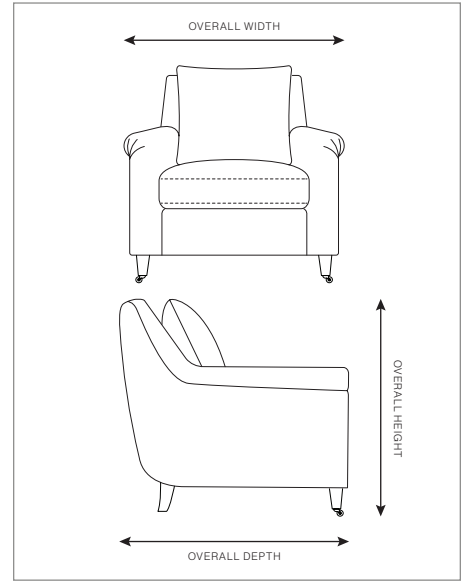
### STEP 1: PLAN YOUR ROUTE

Consider all options for the best pathway to deliver your new piece to the desired space, including alternate doors, garages, or hallways throughout your home.



### STEP 2: MEASURE CLEARANCE

Measure the height and width of all doors and hallways. If using an elevator, be sure to measure the interior depth as well. Check the clearance of all pathways, including opposing walls, ceilings, stairways, corners, and any permanent fixtures.



### STEP 3: FIT CHECK

Once you have determined the most suitable route and obtained all necessary measurements, cross-reference your findings with the dimensions of your selected furniture piece. Refer to the product details section on the product webpage for specific width and height information. Confirm that the furniture's dimensions are less than those of all doors and pathways.

## Delivery Day

Remove any potential obstacles, including furniture, artwork, decor, or rugs. If necessary, remove doors or hinges before delivery as our white glove delivery carriers are not permitted to do so for you.

Our white glove delivery carriers will place your new furniture piece in the room of choice, assemble the furniture if required, and dispose of all packaging materials upon completion.
