#### VISITOR AGREEMENT WITH HOPE NOW UKRAINE

As a guest of Hope Now Ukraine, we will be legally responsible for your actions while you are in Ukraine. For this reason, we ask each visitor to read and sign the following agreement. A breach of this agreement by a visitor could seriously affect the ability of Hope Now to work in Ukraine. Relationships that have been built over many years can be destroyed and the governmental authorities can remove our right to invite guests. Please remember that you are a guest in a country that has a culture different to your own.

During my stay in Ukraine, I, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, agree to be bound by the Christian principles of Hope Now and Kompas Park. I will not engage in illegal activities, I will not smoke, I will not take recreational drugs and I will not drink alcohol. I will not engage in inappropriate relationships with Ukrainians, other visitors or fellow volunteers. In particular, I will respect the sensitivities of Ukrainian Christians in these areas of behavior.

I accept that the use of Hope Now and Kompas Park facilities and equipment is at my own risk. I accept that use of transport within Ukraine arranged by Hope Now and Kompas Park shall also be at my own risk and that I am responsible for providing adequate insurance cover for my stay.

I understand that if this agreement is broken I may be asked to leave Ukraine as soon as practically possible at my own expense.

### **COSTS & RESPONSIBILITIES OF CAMP VOLUNTEERS**

Mission trips cost \$650 for a 10 day or one-week camp experience. This includes in-country ground transportation to and from KBP airport, meals and shared accommodation. Airfare is not included and may be booked by the volunteer ONLY AFTER the group's outbound and return flights have been confirmed. If volunteers wish to return to the USA on a flight schedule different from the group's return, that can be arranged, however the group must still depart Kompas Park together at the end of camp, which is generally around 9:00 am on Saturday.

#### Here is the typical itinerary for one week of camp / 10-day trip:

Thursday	Depart USA (afternoon) from ATL (normally Delta or Delta partner)
Friday	Arrive Ukraine (afternoon) at KBP (Kiev Airport). Ground transportation from KBP to Cherkassy (approx. 2-hour drive in mini-bus) Dinner & accommodation in Cherkassy
Saturday	Spend the day in Cherkassy. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and accommodation in Cherkassy
Sunday	Breakfast, church service, lunch, then depart for Kompas Park late afternoon via mini-bus (approx. 45 min drive). Dinner & accommodation at Kompas Park (Khreschatyk)
Mon – Fri	Breakfast, lunch, dinner & accommodation at Kompas Park (Khreschatyk)
Saturday	Breakfast and depart Kompas Park for KBP (Kiev Airport) via mini-bus.

Volunteers will be involved in collecting items needed for camp, and these supplies will be divided with each volunteer packing and checking **2 x 50-70 lb. pieces of luggage** as checked baggage: 1 x large suitcase supplied by you (weighing 10 lbs. or less empty) and 1 x large duffle supplied by Hope Now. Most space in these bags will be taken up by trip supplies, however some space can be reserved for any personal items that cannot fit into your carry-ons (including any liquids over 3 oz.) You will also take **2 carry-ons** onto the plane – both supplied by you: 1 x small-wheeled suitcase (between 20-21" tall) that will fit most of your personal clothes (many volunteers will leave this small case in Ukraine at the end of the trip) and 1 x backpack for other personal items you will need on the flight.

Volunteers will be responsible for raising their own financial support to cover the cost of camp and airfare. Donations up to \$2,500 per volunteer may be received at Hope Now USA and will be applied to the volunteer's account. Any donations that are received at Hope Now cannot be returned in the event that the volunteer is unable to attend camp. Donors will receive a tax receipt if requested.

Volunteers will also attend team meetings, where team building, and trip planning will occur. It is very important that team members make every effort to attend and fully participate.

Most volunteers bring about 10 small gifts to give out at the end of the trip – these will be for the campers assigned to the team you will be co-leading. Gift suggestions include baseball caps, t-shirts, sunglasses, bracelets, nail polish, soaps, candy etc... In addition, volunteers usually bring 2-3 gifts for Ukrainian leaders that they grow close to. These can be small, inexpensive items that serve as tokens of friendship. These gifts are not required and are at the expense of the volunteer – however if you choose not to participate, that is absolutely fine, and you are under no obligation to do so. Just let Cyndee Knight know, so that we can bring additional gifts that you can hand out to your team.

We make our plans, but God directs our steps. Please pray about your decision to volunteer at Kompas Park. God has much in store for the volunteers that serve there.
