

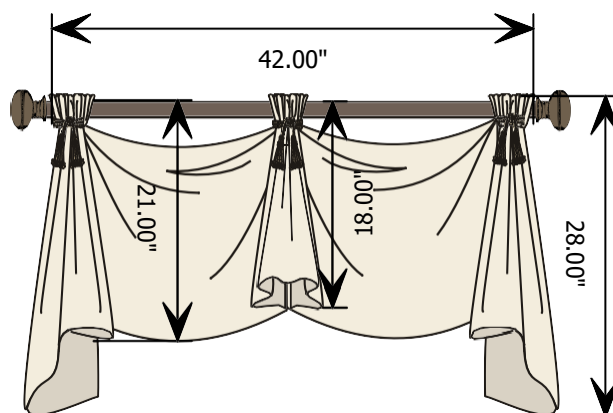


CELEBRITY VALANCE

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Please read all instructions before beginning

- This valance can be adapted to fit any size. Our instructions are for a valance that is 40"- 42" finished width. The information needed to add to or reduce the width is included. The finished length of the valance is approximately 21" at the swag, 18" at the middle horn and 28" at the side jabot.
- We used a decorative fabric for the middle horn and side jabot lining. You can use plain white or ivory lining, but keep in mind that whatever fabric you use will show on the front side of the valance when installed. We used a contrasting fabric for the piping. The swag sections are lined in regular drapery lining (white or ivory).
- Trim can be added along the bottom edge, if desired.
- This valance works best when constructed out of a light- to medium-weight decorative fabric.
- Use a drapery interlining to give the valance the best body and shape. Interlining is a flannel-like, cotton fabric that hangs between the face fabric and the lining. It is available in white and natural colors and can be found at most decorative fabric stores or at www.patemeadows.com. It is *not* the same thing as interfacing.
- This valance is mounted on a 1-1/4" drapery rod. A small adjustment on the rod pocket of the tabs will need to be made if a smaller or larger diameter rod is used.



MATERIALS

These amounts are for a valance measuring 40-42" wide finished. See chart on the next page for other window widths.

These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric.

Fabrics:

2 1/2 yards of decorative fabric for valance front

- 2 yards of contrasting fabric for facing and lining of middle horn and side jabots
- 3/4 yards of [drapery lining \(white or ivory\)**](#)
- 2 1/2 yards of [drapery interlining \(optional\)**](#) [1 1/4"-1 1/2 yards fabric](#) to cover piping
- 3 1/2 yards trim (optional)

**Allow extra fabric for matching of patterned fabric*

- [10 yards of 4/32" cotton welt cord](#)

| Window Width | Face fabric* & interlining | Drapery Lining | Contrasting fabric for middle horn and side jabot lining | 4/32" cotton piping | Fabric to cover piping | Trim for bottom of valance (optional) |

| 20-21" | 1 3/4 | 3/4 | 2 | 3 1/2 | 1 1/2 yds** | 2 1/2 |
| 40-42" | 2 1/2 | 3/4 | 2 | 6 | 1 1/2 yds** | 3 1/2 |
| 60-63" | 2 1/2 | 3/4 | 3 | 8 1/2 | 1 1/2 yds** | 4 3/4 |
| 80-84" | 3 1/4 | 1 1/2 | 3 | 10 1/2 | 1 1/2 yds** | 6 |
| 100-105" | 4 | 1 1/2 | 4 | 13 | 1 1/2 yds** | 7 1/2 |
| 120-126" | 4 3/4 | 1 1/2 | 4 | 15 1/2 | 1 1/2 yds** | 8 1/2 |

**These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric. Allow extra fabric to match patterns and plaids.*

***For multiple valances, a total of 1 1/2 to 2 yards fabric for piping is usually sufficient.*
