Dan had some baseball cards. His Granma gave him 3 more. Now he has 8 cards. How many cards did Dan have to start with?



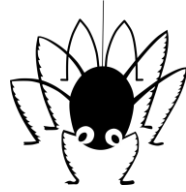

There were some ducks in the lake. 6 more ducks came to join them. Now that made 9. How many ducks in the lake at first?



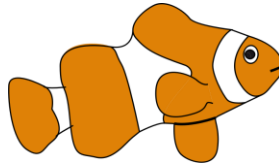

Some caterpillars were crawling on a wall. 4 more came to join them. That made 8 caterpillars altogether. How many caterpillars were crawling on the wall at first?

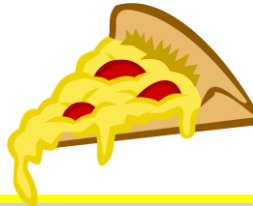

Some cats lying on the couch. 5 more cats came and joined them. That made 8 cats lying on the couch? How many cats were there to start with?



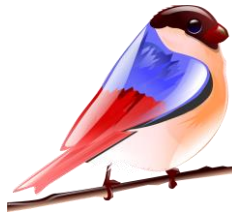

Mom had some cookies on a plate. Then she added 4 more cookies from the oven. There were now 10 cookies on the tray. How many cookies did Mom have at first?



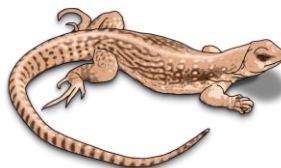

There were some birds in the tree. 8 more birds came to join them. Now that made 10. How many birds in the tree at first?



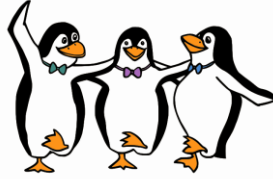
