

## Chaddsford Winery – Scavenger Hunt

Prior to exploring our property and surrounding areas, please make sure to check in at our host stand at the main entrance of the Winery to indicate to staff that you are participating in the Brandywine Valley Wine Trail Scavenger Hunt. When you are done, return to the host stand to show your photos – and claim your gift!

1. Chaddsford Winery shares a property line with the Barns-Brinton House, a tavern built in the early 1700s, now owned/managed by the Chadds Ford Historical Society. Walk the path from our driveway down to the Barns-Brinton House. With your back to the historical property, look up the hill to our farmhouse. Affectionately referred to as The Vintner House, this structure was built by the Brinton family over 200 years ago. Today, it's home to our business office and (hopefully) our future guest house! Take a picture of both houses.
2. Facing the front of the Vintner House walk around the left side of the building. You will find a birdbath overlooking the pond which gives our access road its name: Pond's Edge Drive). Take a picture of both the birdbath and pond.
3. Head towards the pond, making a right onto the gravel road. The gravel road heads up a hill where a large birdhouse should be visible. Walk up the road to the birdhouse. When you arrive, you will find the Bark Park at Pennsbury Township Park. (Fun fact: The birdhouse was featured on our 2016 Barrel Select Chardonnay label) Take a picture of the birdhouse and the dog park.
