Rich and round, Foch shines with blackberry and blueberry compote notes while adding a eucalyptus note that nods back to its French heritage. Aged for 11 months in French and American oak, this wine shines with round and grippy tannins, a refreshing acidity, and tons of complexity to keep you reaching for another glass. Enjoy alongside beef stew, spinach and artichoke dip or sausage and fennel.
