Tasting Notes

Light bodied red with notes of cocoa powder and cherry cordial.

Winemaker Notes

The latest bottling of our house blend is reminiscent of Beaujolais; light and fruity, vibrant, and fresh. The nose is aromatic with notes of cherry cordial and a touch of cocoa. We chip this wine for two months with French and American oak (60/40). The palate is light and refreshing with a hint of tannins and a pomegranate level of acidity. Pair alongside eggplant parmesan, slow cooked brisket, roasted brussel sprouts, or stuffed mushrooms with garlic and parmesan.
