



KEYS OPERATION INSTRUCTION



(1) Power on/off key. Press"ot "to choose power on or power off.

(2) "M" menu/Proceed key.

Press "M" for main Menu to choose functions setting.

You may able to set up brightness, HUE, contrast, saturation, aspect ratio, language, reset, exit and etc. through the Main Menu. In main Menu interface, Press " $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ " to UP/down, then press "M" enter submenu. In main Menu interface, Press " $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ " to "EXIT", then press "M" choose the main Menu interface. It will automatically exit the "Main Menu" within 10sec if no operation.

(3) "V1/V2" two video input key.

Press "V1/V2" key to choose V1or V2. It will show "V1" or "V2" on the top right corner of the Monitor.If no video signal , it will show "NO SIGNAL V1" or " NO SIGNAL V2" . It will automatically turn off within 8sec if no signal.

Notes: These are two systems you can choose in Monitor, "Manual" and "Automatic" system. "Manual" means when the vehicle starts, you are pressing " ७ " button to turn on the monitor. "Automatic" means, when the vehicle starts, the monitor will turn on automatically. The factory original setting is "Manual". if you'd like the monitor turn on automatically, press" ▲ " and " ▼ " at the same time, then Monitor will show "Automatic" and the setting will change to "Automatic", If it's setting to "Manual" again, do the same as "Automatic".

Make sure to keep your "Manual" mode setting on V1 while the monitor is not in back-up mode.

Here the steps:

- #1. Manually turn on the monitor
- #2. Press V1/V2 Key to proceed V1
- #3. Turn off the screen with power button.

**Green trigger wire should connect to the back-up light (12V).

Notes: if V1 connect front camera, pls choose "Manual" state.
