Georges The Tiller Shiraz 2019

Introduction

George Family Winegrowers follow a set of simple yet impassioned mantras. Grow nothing but premium fruit. Make nothing but quality wine. As custodians of magnificent Clare Valley vineyards from the renowned Shiraz fields of Armagh to highly prized Riesling, Cabernets and diverse contemporary varieties. Nick George and son Alex celebrate their region's natural gifts with a respected portfolio of richly characterful wines.



The Tiller Shiraz is the ultimate acknowledgement of the George family's commitment to their beloved Clare Valley vineyards. The winery practises the most respectful sustainable farming methods across the blocks from the precious northern hamlet of Armagh to Auburn in the south.

Vinification

The grapes were harvested on the 12th of March 2019 after some rather warm days forced our hands. However the resulting fruit was jam packed with concentration. At the end of vintage all the best barrels are put aside then we pick the eyes out of them to create the Tiller. The wine undergoes 12 months in 60% new French oak and is then bottled with minimum filtration to maintain as much flavour as possible.

Tasting Notes

From a warmer than average season only the finest fruit has been steered with a steady hand to create a wine of pure elegance and enduring character. chocolate and a mid-palate spike of fresh blackberry. Lip-smacking structure and impressive length make this a very special shiraz crafted to drink now and for cellaring over many years.
