## Schild Estate Angas Brae Shiraz 2022



Schild Estate first established vineyards in the Southern Barossa Valley in 1952. Now with 11 unique vineyards in the area they specialise in premium, estate grown shiraz, old bush vine grenache and mourvedre. The winemaking team, led by Scott Hazeldine, work closely with Michael Schild, head vigneron, throughout out the year to produce wines of balance, interest

and character that reflect the unique subtleties of the Southern sub-region. Schild Estate are best known for their flagship wine, Moorooroo Shiraz, which is harvested from original Barossa vines planted by Johan and William Jacob in 1847. The Moorooroo Shiraz has been rated 99points by James Halliday for the last three vintages (2015, 2016 and 2017).

### Tasting Notes

This Shiraz is a rich and full-bodied wine with layers of dark chocolate, pepper spice, ripe blackberries and plums. Fine-grained tannins, and a touch of smoky cedar completes this wine with a long and velvety finish.

## Woodstock Cabernet Sauvignon 2015



Family owned and operated for three generations, Woodstock has maintained a commitment to capturing the essence of McLaren Vale since 1973. The original Woodstock property was named by English settlers, after their hometown of Woodstock, near Blenheim Palace in Oxfordshire, England. The Townsend Family, received a Crown Lease for the property in 1905, built a

home with a brick well and established the estate as a vineyard and orchard. It has been known as Woodstock ever since.

### Tasting Notes

This McLaren Vale Cabernet delivers layers of flavour. Lifted notes of stewed plums with chocolate and a hint of eucalypt. Time in barrel and bottle has combined all these characters and created a rich and complex wine.

## Palliser Estate Luminary Pinot Noir 2020



Winemaker Allan Johnson is producing consistently superb wines, which reflect Palliser's prime vineyard sites in Martinborough. Whilst Palliser Estate and the Martinborough region have made their name from Pinot Noir, the Sauvignon Blanc is always one of New Zealand's finest.

### Tasting Notes

Vivacious and concentrated, velvety flavours of cherry, plum and vanilla coat the palate, lingering long and lush. Luxury steers clear of decadence as the crunchy red-fruit acidity cleans up the whole finish, leaving a tantalising trail of fine tannin and savoury herbal complexity. Enjoy with Chinese duck, beef brisket and hard cheeses.

## Ironcloud Rock Of Solitude Chardonnay 2023

Ironcloud Estate (formerly Pepperilly Estate) is situated in the picturesque Ferguson Valley, in the hills of the Geographe Wine Region, overlooking Geographe Bay. The vines were planted in 1999 in highly prized red gravelly loam soils. The Estate comprises of a single vineyard with 28 acres under vine made up of hand-tended Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvedre, Cabernet

Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Viognier. The vines are planted north to south on gently sloping hillsides to optimise their growing conditions. Ironcloud aims to produce wines that capture a unique sense of terroir in every bottle and draw inspiration from the great wines of the world.

### Tasting Notes

Bright straw with a pale green tinge. Bright stone fruit, spiced floral notes, and subtle grapefruit. Elegant tannins and a zesty natural acidity ensure the fruit-driven palate finishes long and fresh.
