We're taking you to Luberri winery to meet Florentino Martínez Monje, a family man, and who has Tempranillo and the Terroir of Alvesa running in his veins. These wines that straddle the past and future of winemaking in Rioja. Luberri

is run by whose philosophy is to make wines that are above all honest and true to the terroir and tradition of the Rioja region, and the modern energy of his winemaking.

Tasting Notes

Biga is a cherry-coloured wine of medium intensity, a modern Crianza, with the predominance of fruit to which noble wood contributes shades of complexity. Delicate aromas: fresh and clean fruit, with tones of leather, spices and fine wood. In the mouth it is light, pleasant, emphasising a hint of freshness.

Chaffey Bros Tripelpunkt Riesling 2019



Brothers-in-law Daniel Chaffey Hartwig and Theo Engela are the latest generation of the Chaffey family to ply their vinous trade in Australia. Their hand-made, minimal intervention wines come from small parcels of low yielding vineyards spread throughout the Barossa and Eden Valleys. Drawing

on true old vines and complex soils they see themselves as part perfumer - discovering delicate aromatics; part historian - preserving the purity of pristine fruit and part mad scientist - reveling in the art of small batch blending.

Tasting Notes

Pale yellow colour, with a lifted fragrance of fresh flowers and whispers of citrus blossoms. The wine is just off-dry, the sweetness helping make it more approachable at this tender age. It's very young and bright, will live long and reward cellaring, and it is delicious now. The balance is superb.

Peter Lehmann Cellar Archives Barossa Semillon 2013



The 2013 vintage was our earliest and one of the driest for many years. The weather remained warm to hot throughout but without any extended heat waves. Barossa Semillon, often the first white grapes to be picked on the Valley floor, were harvested at the beginning of February in order to

retain freshness and acidity. The fruit was picked early and fermented cold in stainless steel tanks to retain fruit delicacy. Following a two week fermentation period, the wine was clarified and bottled before being cellared at the Peter Lehmann winery.

Tasting Notes

The nose exhibits a hint of development with toast and brioche notes. The palate has both the typical zesty, citrus flavours of a young Semillon and the beeswax, honey complexities of its age.

Tasting Notes

White Burgundy with a real sense of identity - this Chardonnay has it made. Subtle mealy oak, integrated oak and a clever balance of acidity and fruit. It all adds up to a Chardonnay that trades in the minerality of Burgundy, but with a modern sensibility.
